

ABIENTE SOLSTICE

Ji Rey (Ambiente Solstice) is an Austin, Texas based multi-instrumentalist and electronic composer who focuses on ambient compositions. He has explored many musical arenas, from big band jazz to electronic genres ranging from downtempo to deep house to drum 'n' bass and dubstep. Ambiente Solstice plays the saxophone, favoring the soprano sax. He also plays "keys,"

identifying as a keyboardist before identifying as a pianist. Though his music takes inspiration from a world of sounds, Rey cites his most important influences as Vangelis, Steve Roach, Kevin Braheny Fortuna, David Lange, and Michael Sterns.

Growing up in the 1970's and 80's, Rey recalls hearing "Baker Street" by Gerry Rafferty on the radio during a drive with his brothers—he decided on the spot to learn the axophone. The hits of the 80's, as well as his time in jazz orchestras, would be the soundtrack of his early artistic education and Rey looks back on this era as "the best music ever. Heavy metal, new wave, punk, jazz, electronic, etc. I loved them all." It was not until high school, however, that Rey found electronic music. So recalls the artist: "I discovered electronic music when I found a college radio station airing 'Hearts of Space.' I still remember the program title and number."

Ambiente Solstice is currently anticipating his newest album of ambient works, Abandoned Peace, to be released on Heart Dance Records. With this release, the artist seeks to connect directly with the listener, and to create a symbiotic relationship between artist and audience such that the line dividing the two is blurred; such that each musical step taken is anticipated by all sharing this auditory experience.

Ambiente Solstice's Abandoned Peace is a deep, meditative, and restorative exploration of the colors of the night sky—an introspective lullaby of the ether. This collection of ambient compositions as perfectly suited for active listening as they are for ambient, new age, meditation, yoga, and spa programming.

On Vision of Eden, his second album for Spotted Peccary, Bart Hawkins once again proves himself a skilled sonic architect, building rich and prismatic landscapes with modular synthesizers. His first album, 21 Pulse Eclipse, was pure sonic exploration; Vision of Eden preserves that spirit while adding a narrative layer. Using not a single keyboard.



Hawkins embraces the modular challenge: "to create my own unique sonic signature and shape the character of that sound to tell a story."

Vision of Eden draws its story from the book of Genesis, presenting this time-honed tale in a bold new format. Shimmering fractals of sound guide the listener from Eden's peace to the world's swirling creation to the Serpent's temptation and beyond.

Opener "Garden of Grace" immediately invites the listener into Eden's otherworldly beauty. Warm chimes ebb and flow like a breeze through branches, evoking the latticed glow of sunlight through trees. Sounds of children playing echo through this expansive ambience. On "Sidewinder," jangling guitar rattles—made by placing forks and spoons between the strings—dance over ominous drones to signal the Serpent's approach. A slinky groove embodies temptation: the Serpent's promise of forbidden knowledge. Temptation indulged, "Descent Into the Forbidden Fruit" rumbles like an earthquake in slow motion as subterranean bass warps under haunting hums to capture innocence shattered, the mind pushed to its impossible edge—before a graceful return to nature in meditative finale "Dragonfly Speaks."

Though his fascination with Genesis began in childhood, Hawkins' recent move to a sixty-four acre ranch brought renewed inspiration. While sitting under the trees at his ranch, Hawkins explains, he was "inspired by the dynamical relationship between the Tree of Life and the Tree of Good and Evil and the different ways they affect human life." Here, Hawkins takes a familiar story into uncharted territory. Sometimes serene, sometimes harrowing, yet always immersive, Vision of Eden is complex and dreamlike that thrums with the energy of invention.





It is among the first to link healing music and healing cannabis, whose ancient roots trace back more than 5,000 vears. The 11-track CANNABIS DREAMS features Halpern's signature sound, a Rhodes Mark 7 electric piano. Lush hi-psi soundscapes shimmer with luminous keyboards and hypnotic ambiences. But it is Dominguez's daughter the main muse that drives him to compose, as Forest Robots is a love letter about nature and the legacy he wishes to leave behind for her.

AMONGST A LANDSCAPE OF SPIRITUAL RECKONING

His latest album, Amongst A Landscape Of Spiritual Reckoning, out on April 2021 on Wormhole World Records, explores themes of spirituality, existentialism and ethics, and how each relates to the experience of parenthood amidst great global cultural instability.

This is the follow-up to 2020s critically lauded album 'After Geography' (Bandcamp Daily's Best Of 2020, Electronic Sound Magazine, The Moderns 2019-2020). His music has been featured on Cable Television programming, NPR news broadcasts and has been playlisted on numerous radio stations in the US, Canada, Mexico, South America, United Kingdom, France, Germany, Sweden, India and is also digitally streamed by thousands every month in over 80 countries.

Forest Robots work is often compared to Boards Of Canada, Four Tet, Brian Eno, Cluster, Erik Satie, Harold Budd, and Nils Frahm. His latest work is reminiscent of Jon Hassell, Gigi Masin, Weather Report and Nick Drake to name a few.



Michael Oscillate



One of multiple 2021 releases, Droned Home is the most recent EP of Michael Oscillate and is comprised of just four songs, totalling almost a half hour between them. As is self-evident in the title, this project centres around the use of drones to manufacture an aura of serenity and encourage inward reflection and contemplation.

This music is best listened to with eyes shut, allowing the atmospheric drones and the celestial melodies to move within you and carry you away into a world totally disconnected from the world that you knew before those eyelids met. The 5-and-a-half-minute opener, Subduction Zone, is the height of tranquillity in its astonishing spacey and angelic sways. Hysteria returns to Oscillate's proclivity for the eerie and spectral, which is carried on too through Dwindling. Droned Home closes itself out with the unabating and lengthy, Isolated—which remains both dynamic and gripping through its 11-and-a-half-minute run.

Nocturnal and mysterious, the digital pulses were created with a boundless sense of history and place. Recording preliminary tracks in a castle's vacant wing in northern Italy, Lorenzo took advantage of the winter's semi-isolation to immerse in the historical atmosphere, drawing inspiration from the contrast between the pure enveloping cold and the severe medieval walls.



Lorenzo Montanà is an Italian soundtrack composer, sound engineer and producer. He started in the nineties producing & arranging more than 40 albums with several artists across the electronic, ambient, IDM, jazz, classical and rock genres. His meticulous production style finds a complex balance between melody and intricate beats. He published his first solo album (Black Ivy, 2009) and the 5-CD Labyrinth collaboration series with Pete Namlook on the label FAX +49-69/450464." His work as soundtrack composer landed in the trailer of The Hunger Games 1 &2, Blade Runner 2049, Coriolanus and more. The Disciple's Meditation is Mark's third solo album and the third release in the Disciple Series. Mark explains, "The first, Disciple (617026023120), honors the interweaving of flute and human voice: Guru Mantras by female Indian vocalists blend with the flute to create a deep sense of devotion. The second, The Disciple's Path (617026036922), continues with some of these elements but a stronger focus on steady drumming while the soundscapes reflect the mystifying and challenging aspects of a disciple's path. The Disciple's Meditation brings this series to maturity.

The percussion grooves reflect the beat of life, the heartbeat, the earth; the ever-present drones and their effect of equanimity and serenity expand the calm waters of meditative states of consciousness. Above it all - as if hovering over calm waters - the flute and its long breath is the expression of spirit, much as in old testament Hebrew, 'we ruach Elohim merachefet al peneh tehom' ('and the spirit of goddess hovered above the waters')."

ALASAKO

Masako is a pianist and composer who resides in the Northeastern USA. Since her first album, MASAKO, she has been working with Will Ackerman and Tom Eaton. Every one of her albums either won an award or was nominated for award(s). Her fifth album, Hidden Flowers, was released in June, 2020.

Masako started taking piano lessons at the age of four, and already started to compose tunes when she was five years old. She had the privilege of being a student of Ms. Yuko Yamaoka, a legendary piano teacher who was a judge for the International Tchaikovsky Piano Competition in Moscow, and a vibrant and brilliant performer in herown right.

After a lifetime of making music and teaching, Masako started making recordings only 12 years ago. On her new recording "Wanderlust", Masako is asserting her experience, her building confidence and her voice as a composer and a musician in a new recording which is her declaration of freedom from traditional genre and musicial boundries... "Wanderlust" is a revelation.

Recorded using only analogue synthesizers and voice — no sequencers or programming. It's a piece of pure handcrafted electronica drawing on dark landscapes - the different layers of sound constantly fighting among themselves to stay centrestage. 




THE COMPANY
