Ulrich Schnauss & Jonas Munk

It's been over four years since there was last any new music from Ulrich Schnauss & Jonas Munk. This time around the duo heads in a slightly different direction. On Eight Fragments Of An Illusion, they bring their individual strengths to the table, yet it transcends their previous work conceptually.

These eight tracks are much more ambient and introspective in nature, but with kinetic, polyrhythmic energy pushing it forward. There's a floating quality to Ulrich's synthesizer washes and Munk's guitar patterns, yet the eight tracks are anchored by pulse and compositional direction. There are echoes of blissed-out new age music and kosmische from the 1970s and 1980s, as well as traces of shoegaze-era abstraction and leftfield electronica. But ultimately there's no off-the-rack category that fits it. It exists in its own rarefied space.

Since age 14 I have played, composed and produced electronic music. The old icons have been and still is my biggest inspiration and also characterize the music to this day. Music has always inspired and fascinated me, and I have always had an urge to express myself through music.

My first band was put together by my life long friend Flemming Pedersen, who shared and still shares the passion for synthesizers with me. Our band was called "Synthphonic" and during 1980 - 1990, a lot of synth-music was played and produced.

My private life took a turn and I moved away from my hometown, and at once my working career took away the time to my music, and for nearly 20 years I didn't touch the music. But I was struck by a gastrointestinal illness that put a temporary halt to my working career. Leaving work and finding my way back to my beloved music. In the spring of 2019, the album "concert in cyberspace" by Synth replicants was born and with pressure and a lot of support from my loving wife Christina, and from my friends and family, i decided to release my music public.

The album was aired on the music site "Bandcamp" and released via the music distributon service "Ditrokid".

The music went viral on iTunes, YouTube, Spotify, Napster and many other music services. This was the start of "A new era for me...Tangerine Dream, J ean-Michel Jarre, Vangelis...Since age 14 I have played, composed and produced electronic music. 

Marking 10 years since debuting on Felte, 2022 sees the release of Stareside, their most forcefully elegant undertaking to date. A record of swaying quarantine temperament, Stareside's 9 tracks thread the needle between hope and hopelessness - daydreaming whilst watching the world go mad in the blink of an eye. Not shy of overt rhythm, soaring motifs, and daunting undercurrents, Stareside veers wildly in new directions, yet keeps one hand near the record bin of comforting nostalgia (think early Warp Records, Jon Hassel, and Conny Plank to name a few).

"Karmacosmic - founded in 2003 by Rüdiger Gleisberg and Mathis Grassow originated as a project, grown out of the long friendship of both artists, who have known each other since the early 90s. Gleisberg made a name for himself as a composer for films, in the neo-classical scene and in producing radio plays. Grassow has been a fixture in ambient music for over 40 years; best-known work is "El-Hadra"", which has been a reference in spiritual trance music for over 30 years. Besides the quite different solo paths of both artists, a synergy formed around the themes of philosophy of life and spirituality. The core theme, the eternal questions of life and what comes after, still form the basis of the works of Karmacosmic, which stylistically move in the area of the so-called "Cosmopolitan" music, but follow their own claims far beyond.

The percussionist & music journalist Carsten Agthe, who is himself involved in several projects, including Ornah Mental and Schl@g!, quickly joined them; they already knew each other from the local rock sector, among other things through reviews written by him and cross-stylistic reports in relevant magazines. At times, Agthe was also co-organizer of various events of well-known bands. In order to complete the connection of Orient and Occident, the trio was expanded by another veteran: Dirk Schlömer, who already made a name for himself as a rock guitarist in the early 80s - the most famous band here was certainly Ton, Steine, Scherben - now enriches Karmacosmic and resurrects this project as a real band and as a quartet. His experience as a producer - among others in Peter Gabriel's Real World Studios - but also his hypnotic experiments with Ornah Mental now flow into the third Karmacosmic production.



> We are pleased to announce the release of the EP Yield on 27th April from the acclaimed composer, guitarist, producer and old friend of the label, Leo Abrahams, returning from his many collaborations - including Brian Eno, Jon Hopkins, David Holmes - to create a new release under his name.

> He has released numerous records under his own name; 'Yield' follows 2021's 'Scene Memory II' and the acclaimed improvisation-centred projects 'Krononaut' (with Martin France and Arve Henriksen) and 'Visitations' (with Shahzad Ismaily).

Early solo releases also include 'Honeytrap' and 'The Grape And The Grain' for Just Music.

As part of an intimate and atmospheric collection of pieces, the first single, 'Aways', was written early in the morning after a restless night "layering bell-like guitars played pianistically over a flickering backdrop, the first half asking a question, the second half looking to give an answer and building to an emotional catharsis."



"Ambient music is often misunderstood or mischaracterised as being static or uneventful, and even purposefully so. The best ambient music is highly focused with heightened attention to detail and to the passing of time – qualities which, in turn, it nurtures in the listener."

Cheryl B. Engelhardt is a composer, songwriter and music business success facilitator. She's a mentor for GRAMMY U and has been a voting member of the Recording Academy since 2016.

When Cheryl B. Engelhardt was scheduled to attend the live GRAMMY award show in 2022, she decided rather than fly, she would take a train from NY to LA. But when her dearest friend and collaborator Kevin Archambault died the day the Grammys got postponed, Cheryl decided not to cancel her trip and depart two weeks later. She embarked on what would be a transformative journey and she would become the first person to make a record while on a cross-country train trip. Spending 216 hours (nine days - five outbound and four inbound) in a roomette, seeing the entire country and processing big emotions was just what the Universe had in store to help with her healing process.

The trip resulted in a brand-new collection of nine ambient/New Age songs. From the train, Engelhardt sent files to collaborators to contribute their talents, including GRAMMY-winning artist Lili Haydn, GRAMMY-nominees Sangeeta Kaur and Danaë Xanthe Vlasse, world-renowned flutist Sherry Finzer, and the Dallas String Quartet. Composed and produced entirely on the train trip,

The Passenger album was mixed by Engelhardt upon her return and then mastered by Kim Rosen, making it one of a handful of ambient records composed, mixed, and mastered entirely by women. The project, from idea conception to masters received, took under three months.





April Larson is an artist based in Louisiana who works in the field of ambient drones, to put it loosely. Her work, of which there is a lot (check her Bandcamp), is largely self-released, though she has appeared on labels such as Arell, Larry Crywater and Auditory Field Theory, the latter in collaboration with Matt Bower as Isobel Ccircle?

The bio for April Larson claims that she is the "above-ground representative of a tribe of naga located along the coast of Louisiana." She also makes stellar cycles of drone pieces based on J.R.R. Tolkein's more obscure and mythic works. That last bit might feel a bit precious if the result wasn't so stunningly beautiful: its gauzy textures reminiscent of the very best dissipating dreams of William Basinski or The Caretaker, this record makes loss and impermanence feel like a wonderful thin.

Companion to my three other scores for parts of The Silmarillion: A Light That Illuminates Nothing, Bear Thee Away to the Houses of Lamentation, and Only Phantoms and Delusions. Includes some parts of the Unfinished Tales.




A slow ritualistic descent towards electronic atmospheres of introspection. Within Italian composer Montan 's eight tracks, underground corridors meet immense rooms closed for centuries where echoes of ancient instruments resound as if crystallized over time. His mysterious shimmering electronics, acoustic strings and sound textures softly tumble into a solemn flow abandoned to mists, darkness and nocturnal emotional melodies.

Conceived with a theatrical flourish, DESCENT is a constant of obscured colors, a symphony of slow movements where hauntingly expressive piano, somber cello, understated guitar and hidden chants mesh to reveal a contemporary classical environment. Instruments of antiquity such as the Kithara, the Marxophone, and the Egyptian Oud are resampled in an environment of rich meditative atmospheres; it's an expressive mindscape of stately proportions, a blurred world ever so slightly beyond reach.

The album's passionate electro-acoustic miniatures present a mosaic of inexhaustible electronic microcosms for deep listening, gently descending into complex dreamlike realms and rooms.










An encounter between ancestral and futuristic sounds, we could almost dare to say between the sacred and the profane. On his 42nd album, Italy's jarguna collaborates with Illinois's Chris Russell on a mystical electronic-ambient topography of drone drifts creating dream-like visions opening a look back in time to revisit the daily life of bygone people and maybe experience some of their earth medicine.

The album's inspiration is in fact the imagery of the funeral process. Even if the topic is grotesque to some, in truth passing away is a very important aspect for many ancient cultures, indeed the cornerstone of numerous spiritual and initiatory paths — just see what the Egyptians, Mayans, Aztecs and other ancient civilizations built. The electronic atmospheres are perfect for this theme: sounds without borders, an encounter between drones as a hymn to the gates of life and death.

THE NEBULA VOYAGER

Experimental musician and author, Billy Yfantis, releases his 5th album entitled "The Nebula Voyager." A nebula is a gathering of interstellar clouds that forms a unique body (which can consist of cosmic dust, hydrogen, helium, molecular clouds; possibly as ionized gases). The great majority of Nebulas are hundreds of light-years in diameter. Billy Yfantis explores musically the "Nebula" concept by composing music inspired from the formation of existing nebulas as they are described in official astronomical catalogues.

The new album features 19 instrumental tracks including "City Lights" which was performed at the online edition of the Mrož festival 2020 and a 2021 remix of the previously released track "The Mysterious Trip." The dreamy atmosphere of the album was created by using the Sound Design recording technique through the use of both hardware and software synthesizers. If you are familiar with cinematic soundtracks and music styles such as Avant-Garde, Krautrock, Experimental and Ambient, then you are definitely in the spirit of this release! Billy Yfantis commented on the release: "The main scope of the album was to explore Astronomy beyond the popular science fiction concept.



Poul Winther is a Danish planist and composer who plays music in the genres New Age and Ambient. With his new album "Cosmic Holiday", which is part of a trilogy, he has dedicated himself Into the Ambient Space Genre. The Music can be experienced as a journey in both the outer universe and the inner. For that matter in your own consciousness. Microcosm / macrocosm! The music, which is calm and meditative with its soothing Instrumental Space Atmospheres, is perfect for relaxation and meditation.

Poul Winther

Poul Winther has been releasing music since 2008 both as a solo artist and with composer/multi-instrumentalist Carsten Rosenlund in the genres: New Age/Ambient/Electronica. Poul Winther has worked both as a music teacher and played many Solo Healing- and Meditation Concerts at spiritual yoga and meditation centers in Denmark and Scandinavia. In addition, he makes individual musical soul portraits which are a piece of music that is specially composed to express the individual's soul vibrations.



Peler Frohmader was an innovalor of the second generation of German electronic music. Different from most electronic music artists, he was only marginally influenced by the cosmic sound of Langerine Dream or Klaus Schulze. Rnown by the pseudonym Dekropolis, music which leads to the underworld and creates a sinister and nightmarish almosphere. Frohmader has released numerous albums, but most of them came out on little labels, so they did not gain the attention they deserved.

Already a pupil, Peter Frohmader started to record tapes with alienated sounds in the early '70s and later formed amateur bands like Ranaan and Alpha Centauri. In 1981, he released his first I.P., Musik Aus dem Schattenreich. Frohmader got his inspiration from movies like Nosteralu, books of H.P. Itovecraft and Fidgar Allan Poe, and the paintings of Hieronymus Bosch. So it is not surprising that especially the early works are very dark and disturbing. The excessive use of bass quitars beside the electronics is striking.

PHR FROMMADER



Peter Frohmader was a talepted painter and studied art and graphic design. His mystic airbrush paintings often were used for record covers. The famous Swiss artist D.R. Giger, creator of the alien monster in the movie of the same name, became attentive to him and they co-operated on his film Second Celebration of the Four. Music for TV movies and documentaries followed. Besides his solo albums, Peter Frohmader has worked with musicians of Amon Düül, Embryo, and Emlidi. In the early '90s, two albums were released in the Anited States and focused the attention of a wider public to his music. Later works withdrew from the abostly music of the early days and integrate elements of ambient, peo-classical, and new age music. Peter Frohmader collaborated with quitarist Richard Linhas of French band Heldon and Russian composer Artemiy Artemiev and had various exhibitions of his graphic art and releasing many albums of his own music, his last works Synthetic Trance in 2021, contained all tracks performed using modular electronics and no overdubs.

After the shock recently of hearing the death of Klaus Schulze, Leter passed away on the 2nd May 2022
