
DiN label boss Ian Boddy follows up his 2020 studio release "Axiom" (DiN64) with another vinyl album length slice of vintage electronic music synth heritage. Whilst there are many focusing in on the world of possibilities of modular synths to the detriment of form and composition Boddy uses his 40 plus years of experience to create six succinct slices of analogue warmth and emotion.



The title track which opens procedures is a case in point. Boddy crams into its seven minutes more drama than many would manage in a side length track. Soft textural chords soon give way to a pulsing arpeggiator playing from his venerable Roland System 100-M modular. Just when the piece seems to be settling into a cyclical groove a series of transpositions move the harmonic interest along before a climax of percussion and synth textures soar toward a stunning crescendo.


The next piece, "Messiaen M31", in contrast is a calm, floating track with an unusual harmonic chord progression based on Olivier Messiaen's music theory with a beautiful Ondes Martenot style solo line. "Rings" features layers of sequencers and arpeggios that twist and turn through various key changes toward another stunning climax.

"Teutonium" is pure Berlin School with a thundering Moog bass line interspersed with edgy, glitchy interjections before subsiding to the calm, gentle fluctuations of "Flow".

Finally "Silver Surfer" is a slice of Synthwave fun featuring the crisp tones of the 100-M set against a syncopated bass line and a beautiful Ondes Martenot duet over a transposing sequencer line.

"Coil" will be released on both CD digipak as well as a limited edition 180g vinyl edition.

During the lockdown, unable to do
anything in the world, I turned inward,
adopting a regular practice of listening
with intention while on psychedelic
mushrooms. The mushrooms helped me
to listen somatically, pulling my ears
towards low tonal patterns and the
warped sounds of a broken Mellotron I
had recorded earlier.

I started playing in my studio, creating bass-driven pieces on my vintage Korg synth organ, using a very limited tonal palette.

The pandemic seemed like a strange dream or a surrealistic science fiction story. As a thought-exercise, I imagined this moment as a film; a mental lens through which I could conceive of this pandemic and all of the complex factors which converged to make it happen.

I approached this music as the soundtrack to this speculative science fiction film, an attempt to translate my emotions.



I added the voices and piano supported by flavoring details and rhythmic parts. The final synergies create a fusion of various ambient atmospheres.



Synergies in nature and cosmos provide beautiful results. Everything around us is based on synergistic natural reactions, creating stars, planets, worlds and human life. The wondrous cooperation between people, which in themselves only exists thanks to synergies in the evolution of our universe, results in the development of music, art, behavior, friendships, emotions, and a wide range of activities that make our life more meaningful. Synergies increase the happiness level of the final result. Even forms of synergy can be deadly, as in some cases as symbiosis, but a higher level of beauty and perfection always remains. In this album 'Synergia', MICADO and the musical friends involved created new musical compositions that are built up from individual musical base material to synergetic end results. Modular Analogue and fully digital synth sound together with samples and computer synths are merged into a new musical life, growing, resigned, or evolving from beginning to end like a human life in the womb. A new album with 10 synthesizer music adventures is born. MICADO appreciates the synergistic input from 5 participating electronic music artists.

Time lapse video recordings of moments of symbiotic effects in nature are attractive to see.

Looking to the images inspired me to generate multiple sequencer variants flavored with analogue vague cloud synthesizer leads which glues the sequences to symbiotic entities matching like on a painting.





Berlin electronic duo Fanger & Schönwälder was joined by Cosmic Hoffmann on this five-track EP, the title track recorded at the E-Live Festival on 27th October 2012.

A legend on the German music scene, Klaus Cosmic Hoffmann's guitar and electronic work is well known to all fans of German electronic music, and here, joined with two of its finest contemporary performers, the mix of new and old blood is sublime.

The opener Cosmic features some wonderfully psychedelic and intense guitar from Hoffmann, pulling in riff after riff as the soundscapes, created by Fanger & Schönwälder, ebb and flow and build to a crescendo. Their power builds as the track builds, the momentum is like the tide rolling in, and the way that all three work together is fantastic, bouncing off each other and harking back to the days when Tangerine Dream was a real improvisational trio.

The whole collection here is reminiscent of the mid-70s, an homage to the perceived halcyon days of Krautrock. The three-part title track invokes memories of that era, filtered through contemporary performances, the unparalleled skills of Fanger & Schönwälder and the undoubted talent of Hoffmann.

OCEANICA is an album that began on a trip to the Pacific coast of Chile in early 2021. Nature for me is a lifelong main inspiration, and this amazing environment was totally mind-blowing.

I had the opportunity to compose a good part of the ideas in front of the ocean, during sunsets and moonlit nights. Later in my studio in Buenos Aires, I developed the ideas, and began the process of creation in depth.

The idea was to combine powerful themes, with defined melodies, with others with intricate rhythms and strange harmonies.



SOPHOS

Ulises Labaronnie (Born in Buenos Aires November 1972) Composer, performer, visual artist, lecturer.

He began making music at the age of 15 in 1988, playing the drums for underground rock bands, at 18 years old, he dedicated himself to composition and was influenced by experimental electronics and contemporary music, ethnomusicology and ambient music. He has made numerous tours, concerts, recordings, videos, and productions from 1995 onwards. Making music for movies, theatre, TV, videogames, installations and scientific spreading. He has participated in National and International Festivals, collaborated with many artists and produced his own projects, including Ensamble Circular (1999-2010) and Sophos (2015 - today), he also developed together with synth-master Ernesto Romeo and the violinist Sami Abadi the trio triØN, based on improvisations and sound experimentation.

His sound is a blend of digital complex timbral and analog warmness. Compositions on his own are characterized by a blend of harmony, sound design, elaborated orchestral articulations, an ambient music taste in the climaxes and atmospheres, some tribal use of percussion and sophisticated use of noise and musique concrete, making his sound original and unique.

He is a lecturer in many Academies of Music in Argentina, and also a producer and mentor of many artists.



The anthemic "Find Your Own Way", which stands for individual decision and freedom, is carried by an atmospheric sound foundation and features Deep Imagination y vocals, intoned by mastermind Thorsten Sudler-Mainz with his partner Ann Kareen In the interplay with guest guitarist Achim von Raesfeld, the multi-instrumentalist

present and point to the upcoming album (release date: 2023), on which present and point to the upcoming album (release date: 2023). Imagination will present a style even more strongly influenced by Dark Wave. the eighties.



From the instrumental ambient of the first album Scapes (2005) to the art rock and gothic elements infused My Silent Celebration (2020), DEEP IMAGINATION's music continued to evolve. With the single Find Your Own Way (2022) and the album The Children Of The Moon, released in 2023, the musician allows the influences from the dark wave of his beginnings to take hold as never before.

The merging of atmospheric electronic sounds, ethereal vocals and instruments such as guitars and ethnic percussion is the hallmark of the productions of Thorsten Sudler-Mainz, who also came to prominence in the noughties as the founder of the Cologne-based ambient project Art Of Infinity.

Medially Thorsten Sudler-Mainz presents the music of DEEP IMAGINATION with lovingly produced video clips in which he appears together with his guest musicians.

ORIENT tolociemi

Joe Weineck, who has realized many compositions and productions since studying composition in the 1970s, ranging from rock to classical, from jazz to lounge, as well as fimmunik, always lets ethno sounds flow into his music. The natural instruments and voices from all over the world enter into a symbiosis with rhythms of the "modern age" and instruments of the "modern age".

Just as people in their cultures can complement each other cooperatively, music can exemplify this with an ease, weaving Orient and Occident together, into rhythms and tapestries of sound that invite you on a journey into a world where the sounds and grooves create something new through the melange, something harmonious and telling stories.

This production is quasi also a voluntary abduction into a world, in which the separation between Orient and Occident does not exist, in which one can hear with closed eyes and see pictures, of the stories that are told.

Musicians like Mathias Dörsam on the saxophone shine on some titles, with Oriental Elevator Jan Friede (Kraan) plays drums and Markus Herrman guitar.
