Dave Pearson's love of electronic music started as a teenager when he first heard Tangerine Dream's, Cloudburst Flight. During the early 1980s, he played synthesiser in several rock bands, including Lichfield UK-based Monteagle with founder Mark completely to a virtual instrument environment using Cubase SX3, only using the guitar as a "real" instrument. With such an admirable history of Prog-rock recordings, this latest release from Computerchemist does not tread safe ground with more of the same but in fact delivers a superb collection of Berlin School style tracks using sequences, Mellotron sounds and atmospherics from that genre. Well known strings, flutes and choir sounds abound throughout the tracks but are all given a fresh approach by the melodic and atmospheric nature of each track, each of which is meticulously recorded to give a great listening experience. In a typical Berlin School style, all five tracks are lengthy, with the shortest weighing in at ten and a half minutes and the longest at over eighteen. Due to the clever variation of sequences that evolve in many ways during the tracks, they never become tired and also leave room for some more ambient passages, especially when the sequencers are not active at all.

Overall, this is a great example of the Berlin School style of EM, building the rhythmic elements with traditional style sequences rather than drums and the massive sounds of the Mellotron providing background strings and choirs, as well as lead sounds for some of the nicely executed melodic content.

This may be a change of direction for Computerchemist, but the quality of the music remains of the highest order.

On two days in the spring of 2017, Achim Breiling and Michal Brückner met for spontaneous electronic jam sessions in Michaels studio, and the resulting recordings - oscillating somewhere between Berlin School electronica, Krautrock and spacey experimental freak-outs - form the backbone of this release.

Working on and off between various other projects on this material, Michael at one point invited percussionist Volker Lankow and guitarist to make some contributions. Recording literally hours of additional material (most of which didn't actually end up in the final version), Michaels intention was to preserve as much of the original flow, energy and spirit of the original sessions as possible while carefully editing the recordings towards a cohesive listening experience...

# HANIA RANI On Giacometti

Hania Rani is a pianist, composer and musician who, was born in Gdansk and splits her life between Warsaw, where she makes her home, and Berlin.

Hanía Raní announces "On Giacomettí" a tender meditation on the life and art of Alberto Giacomettí and family.



"On Giacometti" is a collection of beautiful recordings inspired by the renowned artist and family and features some of Rani's most profoundly delicate compositions to date. Invited by film director Susanna Fanzun, to score her forthcoming documentary on the legendary artist Alberto Giacometti, Hania Rani took herself to the Swiss mountains to compose in blissful isolation. As Rani explains eloquently below, the compositions are based on improvised melodies, simple harmonies and structures and inspired by the silence of the mountains as Rani returns to her main instrument, the piano. The results are beguilingly reminiscent of her beloved debut album Esja, but with subtle extra layers of synthesiser, and on two tracks cello from friend and long-running collaborator Dobrawa Czocher.



Edouard Ferlet began improvising on the family piano at the age of 7 and discovered a taste for music, spontaneously apprehended as pure pleasure in sounds and their arrangement. At the age of 18, after passing his baccalaureate and a period at the conservatory, he left to study at the prestigious Berklee College of Music in Boston and obtained his diploma in "Jazz Composition" in 1992.

Back in France, he acquired a solid experience in the field of composition thanks to the diversity and variety of his audio-visual commissions. His music immediately attracted the attention of the critics with its original mixture of swing and formal refinement. A thoughtful work, in which the pianist defines his aesthetic and idiomatic territories which reveals, particularly in the concern for sound, a subtle influence of the Western classical tradition, skilfully reimagined.

His heart remains deeply moved by the sharing of his music through concerts and recordings. Some twenty albums under his name and more than 200 compositions have been published, recorded and played in public.

# EDOUARDERLET

In 2021 the turning point album PIANOïD was released. Faithful to his taste for side-steps, collaborations and experiments, Edouard Ferlet once again takes liberties with musical genres and styles, this time exploring territories closer to contemporary music, pop and electro music. Patiently matured over the years around a set up with two pianos, one of which is mechanical, Pianoïd finds points of equilibrium between composition and improvisation, complexity and simplicity, human and mechanical, in pieces where echoes of the work of Philip Glass or Nils Frahm resound.

After the success of the first album and its remixes, Edouard Ferlet takes up the same device and dialogues with his two pianos: a mechanical piano (Disklavier™) driven by midi controllers, and a master piano (Silent™) on which he improvises. A device imagined in collaboration with the sound designer Joachim Olaya, which extends the possibilities of play to infinity...

To celebrate our 50th release on the Winter-Light label, we invited some of the most talented artists in the dark ambient scene to reinterpret tracks from RNGMNN's acclaimed False Dawn. The result is a diverse and captivating collection of 8 tracks that showcase the originality and creativity of RNGMNN and his Collaborating Forgers.

Known for his work with the band Avec Silenzi, with whom he has released 5 albums, Renan Vasconcelos brings experimental, climatic and noisy music inspired by ambient and electronics as the basis of his creation. At Dramón, Renan can explore the entirety of the artistic project, from his musical performance to the visual work. In this debut EP, he signs the guitars, drum machines and synths and has the participation of Marcelo Malni (Zander), who takes over the bass.

Born in the mountainous region of Rio, Renan experienced the restlessness of Rio before taking refuge among some of the most beautiful beaches in the state. "Búzios was an extremely welcoming place during my six and a half years there. It fulfilled its role of refuge very well. I found a little peace to put my head in order and managed to leave behind certain anxieties I felt in Rio. The name of my first EP 'Ansiedade Morte', a reference to the memory of why I ended up there in Búzios", reflects Renan.

Currently living in São Paulo and back to a hectic routine, Vasconcelos thought of this first cycle of the project as a tribute and a melancholy farewell to the city of Rio de Janeiro.





#### DRAMÓN

Almost nothing is as special as the sky and everything we see in it. The possibility of observing it from below and interpreting its moods makes it one of the most compelling custodians holding the mysteries of our world. Céus, the plural to the word "sky" in Portuguese, describes a sacred place to which we confide our fears, desires, and search for answers. ### A Winged Victory Of A Dividing Pair

Purveyors of contemporary ambient and electronic inspired music, A Winged Victory for the Sullen make a bold return on new album "The Undivided Five". The pair, made up of Dustin and Adam Wiltzie, have created iconic film scores and forward-thinking ambient groups, releasing a series of game-changing records for Erased Tapes and Kranky.

On "The Undivided Five" they rekindle their unique partnership for only their second piece of original music outside of film, TV and stage commissions, creating an album that channels ritual, higher powers and unspoken creative energies.

Their fifth release (following their debut album, two scores and an EP), they embraced the serendipitous role of the number five, inspired by artist Hilma af Klint and the recurrence of the perfect fifth chord.

This album sees them create bold new work built on their foundations in ambient and neoclassical. Since their 2011 self-titled debut, the duo have emerged as part of a much-lauded scene alongside peers like Max Richter, Hildur Guðnadóttir, Tim Hecker and Fennesz.

Their 2014 album "Atomos" was the product of a commission to score a new performance by Royal Ballet choreographer Wayne McGregor, while 2016's "Iris" was the score for director Jalil Lespert's thriller, "In the Shadow of Iris".

### Round Trip SAM ROSENTHAL

Sam Rosenthal ROUND TRIP

John Carpenter and Tangerine Dream soundtracks, Soft Cell minimal synth, and sweeping romantic Jean-Michel Jarre electronics, Round Trip is future Black Tape For A Blue Girl founder Sam Rosenthal's first foray into electronic music. With tracks such as "Looking Glass" keying into the genre that 20 years later would be dubbed Synthwave or Minimal Synth, Rosenthal released this album on February 23, 1984.

The second cassette on his new Projekt label, Side A, captures an early 80s iconic synth sound. Striking a different mood and influence, Side B's "Spotlight Marsh" displays a burgeoning interest in Eno-infused organic ambience. Performed on a Korg Poly-61 and a Realistic Moog Concertmate MG-1, the primitive recording process involved two cassette decks and a cheap Radio Shack mixer; this was cleaned up in 2023 for digital release. In his late teens at the time, Rosenthal displays the initial uncovering of his musical muse on Round Trip; within two years, he left this style behind to release Black Tape For A Blue Girl's debut, The Rope.
