Altocirrus is the inspirational name given to music produced by Sean and Clare McCarthy.


The songs evolve as a reflection of everyday experiences. Considering that we live in the North West of Ireland we experience a lot of different "weather" which you will hear influences many of our tracks.

After their music was played on Harbour FM (102.3 FM) in the UK on Terry Hawke's show "Hawke Chillout Sessions" to a very positive response and also on One World Radio's show in the UK "Man of Two Worlds" hosted by Neil Fellowes Geigertek, Altocirrus decided to take it further with a view to releasing an EP and album.

Sean developed an interest in electronic music through listening to music by The Art of Noise, Ashra, Klaus Schulze, The Alan Parsons Project and Afrocelt Sound System. Other musicians such as Pat Metheny and John Martyn are also big influences.

Sean works as a gold/platinumsmith and finds listening to and producing music stimulates his creativity.

Clare is classically trained to play both piano and violin. Her influences are Vivaldi, Bach, Tchaikovsky, Led Zeppelin, Black Sabbath, Thin Lizzy, Crowded House, Merril Bainbridge and Seal. Clare works as a Clinical Nurse Specialist. Altocirrus is attempting to build a distinctive sound to reflect their mood and experiences through music.





Rudolf Heimann already played guitar and bass in various bands when he got to know keyboard instruments and integrated them into his home studio. Within a few years he became a synthesizer enthusiast and in 1991 he released his first regular album "Strange Delight".

So far, eight albums have been released, all of which reflect Heimann's preference for melodious, structured compositions. Unmistakable is the influence of the rock & pop genre, because Rudolf Heimann was initially inspired by progressive-melodic instrumental music (Alan Parsons, Mike Oldfield, Pink Floyd), before he got to know the classic German synthesizer music of the 70s.

Through his professional activities as a sound engineer and producer, he always remained in contact with handmade music and musicians, so that he could always enhance his instrumental productions with interesting and varied arrangements.

This can also be heard on the current CD "Tiefenrausch". Certainly it's "electronic" music, but with refreshing influences of classical, dark ambient, progressive rock and EDM. On "Tiefenrausch" Heimann sets to music his experiences and experiences of his second great passion: As a speleologist, he has explored not only the numerous caves of his homeland, but also the remains of old mining, ancient tunnels and forgotten tunnels. The highlight here was certainly the discovery of the "Rodener Schlitzhöhle" in 2016.


## JESPER JORENSEN


## The Owl And The Lily

My name is Robbie Currently living in the Midlands, UK. I have been writing music since around the age of 8, inspired by the music of Tangerine Dream, Jean Michel-Jarre, especially the albums Oxygene and Equinoxe, but my main inspiration came from the haunting writing and rich sound of Vangelis, then listening to artists such as Mike Oldfield, who use a lot more rhythmic based music. I wanted to make sure that even in my softer music to use unusual drum patterns, to give it an extra dimension. The one unusual facet to my playing style is that I like to use solo's in my music, almost like a lead guitarist would in a band, these idea's came from listening to Shack Attack and jazz-funk based music of the late 70's and 80's, like Level 42. Later inspiration came from a person who I think is a genius in television music, Jan Hammer, an artist mostly known for the fantastic tv program Miami Vice. So for me, putting all these separate idea's together, created the individual sound of Morphieus, what I am trying to compose is traditional synth sound using many rich ambient textures of strings and choirs, but also using different textures to create a rich smooth but rhythmic music that isn't harsh to the ears, whether on headphones or on a good quality sound system, I want the listeners of my music to sit back and relax, maybe even drift off to the places my music takes you. I don't use any gimmicks, no cover versions, no quantize sequencing, no samples, I write and perform all of my music myself, self produce, the end product totally in house.
