




Dreams Beyond, Sverre Knut Johansen's fifth offering on the Spotted Peccary label, is a wondrous adventure through musical visions and sonic dreamscapes. Inspired by the album's striking and surreal cover artwork (created by Michał Karcz), Johansen reveals a beguiling collection of compositions infused with imagination and beauty. Guiding the listener on a fascinating voyage, the album's nine tracks travel through quiet spaces and mysterious realms frequently propelled by dynamic rhythms that build to powerfully dramatic moments. Using his collection of synths, electronic percussion, electric guitars, and sound design software, Johansen infuses the tracks with a creativity that satisfies the ears and sparks the imagination, weaving melody, rhythm, and texture into a captivating musical tapestry that constantly evolves from beginning to end. Inspired and sincere, Dreams Beyond is bestowed with passion and warmth. It is a thoroughly enjoyable exploration that invites us to follow our dreams into the unknown and beyond, seeking – and discovering – a peaceful paradise of long days and beautiful landscapes, safe from danger, and hidden from the outside world.

### DREAMS BEYOND SVERRE KNUT JOHANSEN

Norwegian electronic artist / composer Sverre Knut Johansen (pronounced Svá-da Ka-núte Yo-hán-sen) hails from Mo i Rana, a lesser-known town in the northern-central Helgeland region of Norway, just below the arctic circle. He has composed electronic works since the early 1990's, developing a strong signature style through the use of melody and form, often thought of as classically-influenced, electronic symphonic compositions. He has previously released material on Origo Sound and his own Origin Music, and has collaborated with artist's including Erik Wøllo, David Helpling, and Robert Ric







Johnny Woods produces improvised synthesizer music from an off-grid Earthship high in the mountains of New Mexico. His 100% solar-powered studio features a variety of esoteric modular synthesizers, like those from Buchla and Wiard, which he has spent the last couple of decades attempting to master.

In 2010, Johnny became involved with LZX Industries, a boutique manufacturer specializing in analog video synthesizers. He is a well-known expert in the field of modular video synthesis, and has performed for crowds around the world, from Coachella and the Sydney Opera House to MoMA, LACMA, and the Hirshhorn Museum.

In 2016, Johnny moved to the mountains, reigniting his passion for audio modular synthesizers. His focus has largely been on the potential of these machines for new methods of improvisational composition. Seeking a true collaboration between man and machine, Johnny constructs dynamically organic systems within which the synthesizer is free to choose its own notes and rhythms. Like sand mandalas, these compositions are the result of a single session sitting at the synthesizer. After hours of programming and sculpting sounds, the piece is recorded. And once the machine is turned off, it can never be recreated again.

Inspired by an eco-futurist worldview, Johnny views the synthesizer as an ideal vehicle for transferring the rhythms and structures of nature into a pure recording of sound. His solar-powered melodies feel perfectly at home nestled amongst the pine trees in the mountains. There is always a hope and optimism in the music, driven by a constant belief that a new tomorrow can be better than today.



Ulla's productions reveal a discerning process of stripping tracks to their essence, letting space, silence, simplicity and repetition be her guide. They lend a magic touch to a difficult and minimal style of music, creating an album that is comforting and tranquil, yet hypnotizing and transportive. Most evidently, Ulla's music is inspired, by emotions and experiences unknown to us, but perhaps best represented in her own words:

"keeping pictures on a wall left there by someone else.

day dreaming about something not real.

hearing a friend walk through the front door.

letting a plant die.

the silence of a room when the box fan is turned off."

### Merrin Karras / Silent Planet



Conceived and composed in two days, 'Silent Planet' is Brendan's first attempt at a fully continuous piece of music. Normally, albums under his Merrin Karras guise take many months, if not years, to put together:

"I wanted to challenge myself to create a mini-album in a short amount of time, not to think too much about it, but just to let it flow and see what happened. Everything was created in one project, but it's comprised of six distinct sections. Several motifs and elements are re-used at various points throughout the work. It's also the first time that I've used percussion elements in a Merrin Karras work".

The mood spans from brooding to almost Balearic at points, with strong elements of Berlin School and Space Music, classic Trance. and Ambient all intertwined.

This hasn't stopped me having adopted a very "Randonautic" approach to my work since the AP "Harmonics" series of works. It quite literally consists of me opening everything up, switching everything on, drinking my breakfast tea, munching on a few ginger biscuits, then taking a few minutes of quiet meditative thought to pick up the feel of the day. I generally ask whatever's out there to feel free to influence what the gadget-monkey does to help those sounds come

I don't want to control the process any more than I have to. Clearly, right from the choice of timbre, tempo and choice of base notes the piece meanders around, although that's my own input I try to let myself feel guided and not to start double guessing the process. Ultimately, The Universe chooses which notes finally come out, how they come out and what key (if any) the piece is most sympathetic to.



On August 14th, 2020 Sine Music released "White Noise", the brand-new single by Sferix. "White Noise" is the first song from Sferix' EP "Take Me Home" which will be released shortly after. The single is available in all well-known download stores and streaming services.

"White Noise" is a grooving and meditative Chill Out track. And then there are those moments without drums, just piano and voice samples. The chord progression is repetitive and always ends in the right key. Feels like floating, breathing in and coming home.

Tauon aka Olaf Gretzmacher is a German producer with over 20 years of experience as can be heard on "Somewhere". He knows very well when to push the energy and when to "Calm" down. This knowledge also showed in his remixes for Thomas Lemmer and SINE.

A few of the tracks have already been released on Cosmic Chill Lounge Vol. 7 (Just Fly), Offline Vol.1 (Blessed), Spring Chill Vol. 3 (Burgeon) besides two more tracks. For "Somewhere" they were remastered and fit into the tracklist perfectly.

Tauon creates a percussive and spheric soundscape in the opening track "Arktis". The synthesizers are quite reminiscent of the now back in fashion 80's sound.

After the smooth entry Tauon pulls you into driving club vibes that run through your chest. Which sounds quite appropriate as it is the title track of the album "Somewhere".
