






B RELEASED SOUND TIME SENSITIVE MATERIALS


Time Released Sound, founded in 2011, is a lovingly hand made, limited edition release music label that is as much an art project as it is a musical outlet. Focusing on modern classical, ambient electronic and electroacoustic sounds, we produce visuals and packaging that are as uniquely beautiful as the music itself.



"Much of the work for My Two Minds Become Air was written and recorded to accompany dance, and are in the form of vignettes. There is a special emphasis on movement, kinetics, orientation, and spatiality. Alongside movement through space, we wanted to conjure the massive expansiveness of the world outside ourselves at the same time as the seemingly infinite space of inward imagination. How might sound be a way of experiencing the ways that the imagination, the material, and the virtual each move through, intersect with, tangle and knot each other in delightful ways? In a way, we wanted to make music that acknowledges the ubiquitous supermodern abstraction of everyday life in the twenty first century."

MATERIALS



Aperus

Aperus is an ambient, electronic musician living in the high desert of New Mexico. His work combines analog atmospheres, field recordings, electronics and photographic artifacts to create unique audiovisual documents.

We're living on the edge of town near a green belt of trees in the high desert of New Mexico. I wake up, get ready for the day, and hear a bird singing outside the window. The window's open slightly so it filters out the background noise while letting the high end pass through unobstructed. I'm struck by the beauty of the sound and begin recording. It occurs to me that the bird isn't just singing, it's trying to signal another bird as it's evolved to do over countless millennia.

We're hiking the La Cienaguilla Petroglyphs exploring a mile long section of ancient symbols. I'm surprised at how many images cover the rocks and canyon and how directly they speak to me. We move slowly from one panel to the next. You point out the highlights while I photograph them with my camera. Some look ancient while others look like the future seen through the lens of the past. The thought goes through my head – "these petroglyphs are a signal from then until now".

I've tuned into a favorite website to work with a high powered radio antenna at a university in the Netherlands. I spend hours moving through the frequencies recording cosmic noise, news reports, and obscure number stations. A few more adjustments and the shortwave transmits a call to prayer as the audio recorder runs in the background. The needle's not quite on the frequency so the singer sounds squelchy and out of focus while a voice from another station occasionally bleeds through.

After three iterations, the title of the album becomes clear and I feel compelled to explore the ideas I've gathered.

During the day I sometimes find myself staring up at the moon. When I do, I'm transported back to the school playground, where as a child, I would stand transfixed, doing exactly the same thing, as every-body and everything swirled around me. My classmates and I were born in the '70s, in the shadow of the Apollo missions and a combination of what we were taught at school and everything that was on TV as we grew up proved to be enormously powerful. My fascination with Apollo, space and the Universe has never gone away.

About a year before the 50th anniversary celebrations for the Apollo 11 moon landing I was watching the film 'First Man' when I heard the line "they are sailors of the sky", which I thought was very interesting and poetic. A few days later I was walking on the beach on a summer's evening, I istening to the hypnotic sound of the waves lapping. In my mind I was comparing it with the gentle transit through the blackness of space and something clicked. This was my next project.

The centrepiece of this album, originally to be a 45-minute track but now presented in seven parts is a collection of musical short stories, based on the Apollo 11 mission that finally put humans on the moon.







Thorsten Quaeschning (Tangerine Dream, Picture Palace music) and his music define the style of the sessions in the UFA Fabrik and also of the second edition of BEHIND CLOSED DOORS produced in the LIDO in Berlin, Kreuzberg. His real-time-composing / improvisation skills give the guest musicians a great space to show their art and talent. Bringing such different musicians and music genres together creates magical moments in every session.

Stimulus Timbre


Stimulus Timbre is one of the musical aliases of Maltese composer Keith Farrugia. You may also know him under his "Sound Synthesis" moniker.

His music gently grabs your attention with a variety of influences, each with a distinctive twist. It makes you listen intently, drawing you in with intricate sounds and timbres that slowly unfold and unravel into a beautiful journey. Electronics and emotions intertwine to give the listener a deep, melancholic and almost surreal feeling where time is lost and nature seems to be closer than ever.

Whilst gaining a strong fan-base from having a number of digital-only releases under his belt, "Unfolding Cycles" will be the first Stimulus Timbre album to be released on CD and has been long overdue and highly anticipated.

Off Land

Off Land follows up 'Field Tangents' with 'Welkin Paths', a beatless, seamless, ambient kaleidoscope of shadow-play. 'Welkin Paths' continues the sound of 'Field Tangents' and evolves it into something darker. The album combines live performance audio merged with studio sessions to create something that is both unique and familiar. Archived field recordings from various times and locations form a subtle spine, connecting the album's sixteem tracks. Richly melodic and eerily emotive, 'Welkin Paths' transports the listener to a darkness outside of day and night.

Mountain Guide

"Mountain Guide has been written and recorded for over a year waiting for the right moment to be released. It was a long process, but at the same time a very nice learning time."

Francisco Sonur is a musician/producer (born in La Plata, Argentina) but currently resides in Sydney, Australia. He says his challenge has always been the same, to transmit what words cannot name.

Tapes loops. Ambient soundscapes. Field Recordings. Toy instruments. Almost everything that can be used to express emotions can be found in his music.

The main concept of the Mountain Guide EP was to create a dance piece, but at the same time capable of leading us to introspection. It is an EP that aims to take us through the beautiful trails until we reach the top of the mountain.

108 starts with familiar notes of the piano yet the higher you climb, the more exotic and hyperreal your surroundings become. Glossy neon synths slide past you and glitchy textures bring your landscape to life.

As you climb you are again met with the familiar, except you now view this in a new light. The expression of the piano reflects your oneness with nature in this moment, and as you go to climb again, the endorphins begin to flow through you.

Francisco's main musical references are Explosions In The Sky, This Will Destroy You and V8 and his work has been compared to that of Kiasmos, Christian Loffler and Marcus Fischer.

With their debut album "Meerblick" the two already made a statement in 2019. The album reached the iTunes charts and was highly appreciated in the scene.


With "Bergblick" a new album should be created, where the two artists did not want to make any compromises. The bar was set high!
