

These fantastic soundworlds can make you think, or dream, or revere the bleeding edge and horizons of modern science that stretch far beyond our regular consciousness. Just follow these gorgeous sequenced patterns and airy melodic lines to probe the Atmospheric Influences, to find yourself somewhere inside the combined functions of Covering Spaces, to take a glance from under the Veil Of Our Memory, to explore the unwitnessed plexi of Entangled Tachyons, to glide on a brane Beyond The Cauchy Horizon to see the mysterious Ion Mirage and - with eyes wide open - how (Space)Ships Set Sails... and to sail on them beyond the bounds of anything we can imagine.

Being a scientist, ORBIFOLD C weaves his musical story using higher mathematical concepts and the romanticism of fundamental science. To me this is easily the most romantic space-music about the most complicated scientific theories of Space and the Universe. Long vistas of melodic sequences and notes scattered like a myriad of stars in the dome of the night sky, lit with the bright meteors of lead-lines...

"Apeiron" – This term was introduced by the ancient Greek philosopher Anaximander and means an infinite and boundless primordial substance from which all things are born. Modern philosophy and cosmology do not operate with this term: we currently have much more sophisticated theories of the birth of the Universe (in particular, the Big Bang theory). Nevertheless, a concept of apeiron is a part of the legacy of ancient philosophy and has a certain aesthetical and conceptual appeal.

ORBIFOLD C

Damian Tangram' aka 'The Good Omen' creates Live Electronica that is ambient, rhythmic and clear, with distinctive melodies.

Performance encompasses the feel of hardware: with a combination of analogue monophonic synthesizers, digital multi-timbered sound modules, sequencers and FX units with real time control. Strange emanations, improvisations and multi-layered sequences means that every performance is unique experience.

Influences come from diverse background such: Jean M Jarre, Kraftwerk, Tangerine Dream, Kitaro, Klaus Schultze and also Asian (particularly Sri Lankan) musical styles.. Performance:

Caterina explores the psycho-physical effects of repetition and pattern-based operations in music, by investigating the polyphonic and polyrhythmic potential of sequencers to draw severe, complex geometries in time and space.

CATERINA BARBUERI



Dimitri Käch Guitarist/Composer/Producer from Zürich, CH

Jan Wagner is a pianist and producer. With his personal work he explores a simplicity of expression, one that maximises the emotional truth of each composition.

Porto Do Son is a region on the Atlantic Coast, where Jan Wagner and Dimitri Käch met during the summer of 2019. They spent the long days together enjoying the serene rustling of the sea and found a place where they could create music unbounded.

When they returned to Berlin, they locked themselves into a studio for four days. The ocean, the landscape and the light were still everywhere. Headphones were like shells that you hold to your ear to hear the endless sounds of the sea. Everything moved in the rhythm of the waves. Dancing water became ambient guitar textures, melodies passed like streams of fog in the sunlight, pulsing guitars and synthesizers towered over the horizon like clouds. The songs on "Porto Do Son" were created without many words and in chronological order. The album is a declaration of love to the Atlantic: wild, dark blue and beautiful.

Ornament — an information carrier and a coding element for a unique and complex algorithm that modulates the state, space, intention, and path.

Trace inner power into other dimensions.
Encrypt intent with the ornament and weave your bright oscillation into the fabric of Existence. Explode as the calm light and jump into the Immeasurable.



As early as the mid-1960s, the young Harald was fascinated by all the sounds produced by electric guitars, drums and organs. When he felt that making music was becoming more and more important to him, he bought his first electric guitar, which he amplified at first using an old tube radio. At the age of 15 he founded his band "Guul" in school, which, was influenced by Krautrock bands like Eloy, Nektar, Jane or Kraan.

Years later, after various bands, dozens of studio productions and a tour with the American bands "Molly Hatchet", "Great White" and "Wishbone Ash", Harald gradually realized that he no longer really felt at home in tough rock and mainstream. He went back to his roots, which had been a spiritual journey from an early age, in the following years produced ten albums from the field of esoteric music under the project name "Sahurê Music" in his own home studio. Here his music presented itself far less guitar-heavy than before. He drew his emotional depth from floating synthesizer surfaces, interesting sampler sounds and unusual instrumentation on the computer.

THE FLOW -

In spring 2002 he happened to meet his old friend Klaus COSMIC HOFF-MANN-Hoock (MIND OVER MATTER), whom he knew as a 'space guitarist' from the wild 70s "Krautrock times" .In the following months, through joint, spontaneous jam sessions, Harald gradually rediscovered his old love for the guitar and guitar effects devices with their often mysterious sounds. Strongly inspired by this, he produced his new CD 'Space is everywhere', on which he knows how to combine computer-generated electronic space music with his fiery rock guitar to form a living organic unit. Shortly thereafter his latest production "Restart from Sedna" was released. A 7-minute short version of the title track will appear in June on the new Schallwendesampler, "Schallplatte 7". Harald has released 17 albums on MellowJet Records, "The Flow Of Energy" his latest release showing a much more synthesize structure, strong on melodies and epic solos.









Peter Beasley

Originally a drummer, Beasley moved to electronic music in 1985, co-founding AMP Records with Mark Jenkins and Ashok Prema. He toured the UK in 1986 to promote debut 'Coruscation'. His second album 'Imaginary Soundtrack' was recorded in 1991-92, but not released until 2009 and a live album 'UK Tour 1986' followed. Fighting Parkinson's Disease since 2002, his latest album is 'Beetoota' (Nov 2020)

These are my earliest recordings dating back to 1981/82 when I had fairly primitive equipment (see below) and could barely afford a reel of tape. I have kept the recordings pretty much as they were (no overdubs), just adding a splash of reverb / noise reduction, etc on some tracks.

Some pieces were composed for 'Quark Video' - a Science Fiction videozine directed by brilliant young SFX animator Kevin Davies who went on to work on TV's 'Hitch-Hiker's Guide to the Galaxy', 'Terrorhawks' and Disney productions.

"The Shape of Solitude" is Vidna Obmana's collaboration with Belgian guitarist and synthesist Serge Devadder. The album marks once again Vidna Obmana's constant strive for experimentation and expanding his oeuvre with new combinations, blending genres so to speak. Influenced by way more than only the ambient music he stood for, Vidna Obmana believed in music that exist beyond classification and that also the genre in which he operated could use way more than the standard approaches. THE SHAPE OF SOLITUDE is an unique album in his oeuvre: bold, abstract, emotionally-charged and eerie.

"The Shape of Solitude takes Vidna Obmana's music nearer the realm of the Avant-Garde. This collaboration with guitarist Serge Devadder demonstrates Vidna Obmana's willingness to lead the audience, not persue them; fans of his gentle soundscapes or tribal grooves will find themselves challenged by this CD. The source for all the pieces was the guitar. Devadder's already contorted riffs were bent even further by Vidna Obmana's studio wizardry. Even the pacing of the album is somewhat difficult: a piece of dissonant outside music - followed by something warm and mysterious - into a harsh studio mutilation of yet another twisted guitar loop... The music is questioning and plaintive, completed only by a listener's comprehension. Fortunately, the music is as interesting as the process by which it was realized. At moments edgey and inpenetrable, at others deep and serene, The Shape of Solitude is a successful experiment in the use of timbres and sounds to portray moods and feelings avoided by most musicians." - Chuck van Zyl/STAR'S END



Strie - Sléptis


Originally released on Soundscaping label

Sléptis, translating to hidden from its original language, is the debut album of musician Strië. The music defines any particular genre classification, but includes elements that connects it with classical, jazz, electronic and is thoroughly drenched with cinematic aspects and borrows loosely from the neolithic genre acoustic doom. With this outset, and Strië described the album's gestation process as one in which the sounds and the story of Sléptis sought her out, rather than vice versa, it is with a veil of the enigmatic and apparent semi-obscurity, Soundscaping releases its third title.

It would seem that Iden Reinhart is as elusive as her music, and Sléptis is certainly an album which reveals its secrets very reluctantly. This is actually what is fascinating about it, and continues to intrigue as the listener become better acquainted with it. It never becomes truly familiar though, its many meanders and hidden layers ensuring that enough remains concealed to retain part of its mystery.











With the new album "Floating Waves" Faber presents again an album with very catchy and playful melodies. The sound flows along and takes you on a journey through Faber's sound worlds. And on this album he succeeds in doing this again really well. By the way, also in sound, because here you can hear the musical development since his first album. And that was 11 years ago now. As with his earlier works, elements of the classic EM merge with ever new ideas and sounds, thus shaping the typical Faber sound. The result is always rousing and fresh as on the first day. "Floating Waves" is a homogeneous album, which leaves a lot of time for dreaming and enjoying. Perfect for the dawning, dark season. Let yourself be surprised once again by a very entertaining Faber album.







Viragi

Spirals is the lead track from next year's EP 'Into the Clear Light'.

Beautiful and extraordinary, Viragi's music is a spiritual and mystical mixture of east and west. Featuring hypnotic multi-layered rhythms, guitar, enigmatic voices and inspirational sounds from a vast musical landscape, he makes modern ambient music. His album 'The Seven Heads of Propaganda' released some 20 years ago remains a classic in the genre to this day.

Viragi lives in the depths of the English countryside and travels extensively in Asia, Africa and Europe. He spends his time making music, collecting and trading in art and digging his garden, listening to music all day, everything from classical to world to pop and rock.

"To me ambient music is about creating spaciousness and atmosphere whilst retaining a harmonious melodic thread to keep the listener engaged. No surprise at the rising interest in this form of music given the trying times that we live in."

Qaett

"'Undercurrent' is a drifting soundscape, that meanders and swirls, like the currents and tides of the sea, by which it is inspired."

'Undercurrent' is one of three beatless, meditative and pure ambient tracks which together will form the upcoming Molten EP - scheduled for release early next year. It is peaceful and lo-fi, minimal and pensive.

Having released music in digital and physical form on several labels since 2011 under a different alias, Qaett is a return to basics. Under this guise, Qaett creates ambient music in its purest form, neo-classical piano music with strong lo-fi influences and dreamy, melancholy beats.


"The kind of ambient music I like draws the listener into sonic environments to explore rather than traditional songs. It offers momentary windows into these other worlds. It meanders, using sparse melodies and subtle changes to grab some attention, but at the same time stay in the background."

Echaskech

"Dust Storm is an exercise in controlled random modulation - a way of allowing the machines used to live and breathe themselves. The machines used produced a lot of background noise including a dusty sounding earth loop leaving a feeling that you are in the eye of a dust storm."

Echaskech are a London based electronic music act drawing on numerous influences ranging across techno, acid, IDM, classical and drum and bass. With three album releases on Just Music alongside diverse acts such as Jon Hopkins, Marconi Union and Digitonal and a number of single releases on The Ambient Zone, Echaskech have seen fantastic radio support from BBC6 Music and gained positive reviews across a range of press including Mojo, Drowned in Sound, The Crack, The Skinny and The Irish Times.

Dust Storm is the first single from the EP 'Mirrors' scheduled for release early in 2021.





Green Isac Orchestra



Morten Lund and Andreas Eriksen took their adventurous 25 year Green Isac collaboration to a new level when they expanded the duo to a five member ensemble and rechristened themselves Green Isac Orchestra in 2015. "b a r", their second album as the full-fledged Green Isac Orchestra and the seventh Green Isac album overall, is a brilliant expression of their electro-acoustic blend of kinetic rhythms, inventive melodies, and organic soundscapes.

Rich with a generous helping of world-flavored percussion and minimalist textures, the music on "b a r" is a compelling and often energetic fusion of fourth-world rhythms with a progressive edge. The lively trans-continental grooves maintain a solid, forward motion throughout the dynamic moods and interludes of refined, wide-open spaces. Acoustic instruments including piano, cello, marimba and a variety of drums & percussion work in concert with live electronics such as synthesizers, mellotron, electric guitar, therevox, and gizmotron, to create a dynamic and inspired set of tracks that overflow with imaginative originality.

"Green Isac Orchestra is the extension of the duo Green Isac," Lund explains. "It was put together in order to play live versions of Green Isac material, but soon the band started to make new music. Minimalist and ambient were the core ideas in the beginning, but on 'b a r' there are several hints to prog."



Back after nearly 30 years away, Sampanviking started playing and producing again in 2015.

Sampan combines complex synthersiser sounds and formal music phrases to create deep atmospheres and complex sonic crescendos and all keeping faith with the mystic pagan sound of the 70's Krautrock pioneers
