






# CITY OF DAWN Nocturne



Nocturne is a work of art dealing with evening or night. A calm melancholy mood, and a clear melody floating with orchestra chambers, minimal field recordings, and some faint drone billows to accompany the dreamy compositions.

The album is a follow up of "Aubade". It represents the evening scenery and reflective emotions of sadness, anxiety, despair, and loneliness during personal experiences. Damien hopes to bring listeners into healing and reflect as to tell us that we need to take care of ourselves and help others. We are not alone.



## ERIK WØLLO: RECURRENCE

Following his acclaimed 2020 collaboration with American synthesist Michael Stearns (CONVERGENCE, PRO371) renowned Norwegian ambient / electronic artist Erik Wøllo returns with 2021's RECURRENCE. An intensely detailed fusion of elegant compositions and deep atmospherics, it's a gleaming sonic journey — a timeless dreamlike pilgrimage revisiting the sound and feel of past moments with an essence of eternal renewal.

Delicately evocative synthesizer atmospheres are skillfully balanced with pulsating rhythmic passages. Wøllo's trademark processed electric guitars, synthesizers, occasional acoustic guitars and percussion create a cohesive structure that bonds the pieces into a warm, breathing continuum. Conceived to unfold as one unit, the tracks are movements drawing the listener into a deep, adventurous flow.

I chose the title RECURRENCE," Erik reflects, "because much of the music is built upon the idea of presenting a theme or a melodic element at the beginning of each song. This element is repeated later but within a new musical environment that evolved during the progress of the composition. It is a simple idea I've used on previous albums, though it's more defined this time around. Compare it to a place you revisit and a new occurrence of something that happened or appeared before are revealed. On the revisit you explore new angles, seeing and feeling new aspects of the same experience."

Electric Sound

Electric Sound Bath is a Los Angeles-based duo comprised of Ang Wilson (modular synth and singing bowls) and Brian Griffith (bass guitar and electronics). Inspired by the sound baths made famous by the Integratron, ESB uses singing bowls, as well as electric instrumentation to create similarly dense wombs of sound that envelop the listener. Taking cues from nature, esoteric philosophy and decades of likeminded musicians, Electric Sound Bath creates accessible music that is equally at home in a remote ashram, as well as an urban performance space.

Their latest, "Of This World", began as commissioned pieces that evolved and morphed over several years via purposeful reimagining and unintended happenstance. This long-form creative process mirrored the duo's own life trajectory and experiences 'of this world'. The result is a celestial wash of MIDI-driven modular synthesizers crafting slow, unfurling caverns of sound. The type of deep, meditative tones that reward loud and close listening. Allow this music to patiently flow over you, reveling in the crystalline details and heavenly peace.



## Ephemeral Worlds

Robert uses music to create atmospheric experiences. His music would best be described as Ambient Electronic Soundscapes, New Age, or Neoclassical. He creates atmospheres that are sometimes cosmic and floating, sometimes dark and mysterious, but most often peaceful, relaxing and inspiring.

and feel.


"Unlike many types of music that try to get from point a to point b, I believe ambient music is trying to capture a moment in time and the complexity of nature."

It evokes ideas of the earth and life undergoing constant change."

Richard Pike is a London-based Australian award-nominated score composer & multi-instrumentalist. His ambient/experimental solo pseudonym is DEEP LEARNING. He is also known as frontman and producer of Sydney pioneers PVT (Pivot), released on Warp Records UK and Felte US.

About DEEP LEARNING he says: "It is the electric aero-pulse of bliss. These are the texture residue songs of childhood dreams. The unstable strength of solitude. The sweet anxiety of a cascading fog. The moment where the data-music unfolds to lay bare it's triumphant meaninglessness and vast uninterruption. It was always there and wants for nothing. If you open the door it can bring cosmic









In 2016 while working as a Deputy Sheriff in Phoenix, Arizona, Bryan was shot in the line of duty at a traffic stop.

During his recovery, he started to learn how to play the guitar and quickly became an avid student of the guitar and music theory. Several years later in 2018, while playing relaxing music for his son who has ADHD, Bryan discovered a unique way of blending both rhythmic and non-rhythmic musical parts, along with very specific frequencies to help his son relax and fall asleep. Working with a close friend who is a psychiatrist and neuroscience expert, Bryan created this unique, complex, and scientific recording method, which is now patent pending. For the ADHD brain, which is capable of multitasking on so many levels, this recording process completely interrupts the OODA loop.

### Subminimal vs. Rayspark Industries

Móatún 7 is a record label from Tálknafjörður, Iceland, run by Futuregrapher, focusing on releasing 7" lathe cut records and sometimes other formats as well. Physical copies are limited, but digital is always available. 7" are done in Iceland by vinyll.is -limited to 20/30 pressings for each release. CD's, or other formats, are done in larger quantities.

Space & Time from the forthcoming album STARDUST'





After two years since her debut full-length release, Grand River presents her second album "Blink A Few Times To Clear Your Eyes" on Editions Mego.

The 8 track LP shows an evolution towards a more experimental side of the Dutch-Italian composer which is here superbly combined with her ability of creating melodies previously heard on her 2xLP "Pineapple", released on Spazio Disponibile in 2018.

"Blink A Few Times To Clear Your Eyes" expresses how acoustic instruments can be perfectly merged with electronic and analog synthesizers to become one new organic whole.

The composer, whose birth-name is Aimée Portioli, brings the listener along on her personal explorational journey of expressions within a certain genre. The title of the album indicates the desire to explore what is new and see what is around us from different perspectives.

The album opens with the track "Side Lengths", a complex and dreamy sequence made with one of her favorite synthesizers, the Yamaha DX-7. From there we are brought from extended panoramic sound design and cinematic ambiences, back and forth to synthetic melodies, field recordings, strings and for the first time ever, Aimée's own modified voice in the closing track "All There Now".

Recorded primarily at her home base in Berlin, Grand River's music is pure, magnificent and elegant which documents a solemn atemporal story where her experiences are translated into another language.
