Nicholas Gunn

Music gives life to everything. In a chaotic world that often seems in turmoil, music transforms every cell of our being and gives us hope, a sense of purpose and direction, reminding us that the connections we make with each other and our naturalworld are central to our happiness. "This is our Sound Condition" says Nicholas Gunn. Four vocal tracks featuring the stunning performances of Alina Renae are framed by instrumental tales of bliss as Gunn also welcomes back a familiar friend this time around.

Born and raised in the UK and a student of the Royal Academy of Music, Gunn has produced and composed over 21 studio album recordings, as well as countless other productions, reaching millions worldwide. Over his long career, which spans several decades, Gunn continues to push the threshold of experimental, ambient and electronic works fusing past and present with a sound that is uniquely his. Combining guest vocal performances alongside a lyrical style and melody that is unmistakably Gunn, he now finds himself making a mark across multiple genres. 2020 showed us that Gunn's work as a composer and producer not only topped charts in ambient and electronic music but also within the dance music community. Industry remixes on dance label giant Armada Music are fast becoming A State of Trance "future favorites" worldwide.




Peter Calandra


"Ambient Tuesdays" is a collection of musical performances culled from the weekly YouTube series of the same name that Peter Calandra created and published between 2019 and 2020.

The music tells stories in sound and ranges from spacious and emotive piano based music to beautifully scored orchestral music.

Peter Calandra is a prolific composer and keyboard player whose solo albums are wonderfully diverse, spanning world music, jazz, contemporary jazz, new age, pop, and neo-classical. The thread throughout his music is the lyrical expressiveness of the compositions and purity and purposefulness of the musicianship. Three of his recent albums of original music -- "First Light" (2015), "The Road Home" (2017) and "Carpe Noctem" (2018) were nominated for ZMR Awards.













With Other Weather, composer and soundscape artist Jeff Greinke presents an elegant musical landscape comprised of delicate compositions and harmonically rich ambience. The eleven slowly unfolding tracks offer multi-layered textures that weave acoustic and electronic instrumentation into a gossamer soundscape that shimmers with the stillness of a perfectly calm atmosphere in the warm light of early dusk.

As with 2018's Before Sunrise, Other Weather spans the genres of modern classical, electronic, and ambient as it gently evolves through a refined set of impressionistic ambient chamber music. Blending electronic ambiences and effects with an acoustic ensemble that includes cello, viola, violin, French horn, clarinets, flutes, and small percussion, Greinke realizes his musical vision through an empirical process of improvisation and experimentation, combining tracks and layering sounds, and uncovering the magical moments as they reveal themselves.

The title Other Weather refers to Greinke's very personal and experiential relationship with the weather, especially the beautiful and sometimes indescribable meteorological phenomena that aren't often noticed or talked about. Greinke explains, "My interest in the weather has always been predominantly experiential, and as I get older I find myself attracted to its subtler and quieter aspects. I see a connection between this interest and the kind of music I like to make. This feels especially true with this album."

Jeff Greinke has been a composer since 1980, and he has dedicated nearly 40 years to making and recording music. He has performed throughout North America, as well as Europe and China, and his music has been heard in theatre, radio, art installations, and major motion picture trailers. Other Weather is Greinke's 20th solo album, and his fourth on the Spotted Peccary Music labe

Lisa Bella Donna is an internationally acclaimed recording artist, composer, modular synthesist, sound designer, educator, and clinician. She has decades of experience as a session musician, educator, as well as developing extensive techniques with musique concreté, modular synthesis, analog & digital recording techniques, microtonal music, orchestration & film composition.


THE WORLD SHE WANTED

Since the first listen, these songs have only increased in emotional depth and complexity, each one a doorway into another world. We invite you to step through and open your heart to new ways of listening as you are touched by the beauty and grace of this album.

"The world she wanted was written and recorded shortly after I decided to leave the city and move out into the quiet countrysides of the Appalachian Mountains. It was a definitive and beautiful time to build a new foundation and allow for unfolding musical inspirations to bear new fruit in a new, everlasting environment. Initially, I composed "The world she wanted" with the intentions of never releasing it. I just wanted to create a very open, personal, self-portrait of sound and light with these pieces.

It's quite possibly my most revealing album I've ever recorded. I feel the best art comes from when the artist truly stands naked in the manifestation of their craft as it unravels from the core of our most personal intentions.

This music is a very intimate experience for me. It's very far removed from repertoire or recital. It is the ritual and resonant circulation of many previous chapters of challenge and change. It's a tone poem of prayer and gratitude of having another chance to manifest and reveal harvests in the gardens of a new life. For I am truly grateful and inspired to witness and be present in this chapter of my life.



Wolfgang Riechmann

There is a sadness to it that becomes almost unbearable if you are aware of Riechmann's tragic fate. Only 2 weeks before the release of his album, he was brutally stabbed to death by two complete strangers while taking a walk with his girlfriend in the picturesque and peaceful old town of Düsseldorf. It was an act of utter senselessness, there was no motive and Riechmann was a random target.

This tragic end of Wolfgang Riechmann's life before his solo debut was released inevitably colors how to listen to Wunderbar, but taken on its own merits, the album is an enjoyable if not necessarily classic effort in experimenta '70s German music, a blending of rock and synth instrumentation at once playful and slightly spooky. The opening lope of the title track sets the tone, sounding like it should soundtrack some odd sci-fi series of the time, with a lead melody alternately played on flanged guitar and serene keyboards as a steady beat chugs. From there, the musician explores a variety of familiar-from-the-time styles as he goes -- rhythmic synthesizer pulse and drones on "Weltweit," stately keyboard melodic ambience on "Abendlicht," and the strong march of "Himmelblau," one of two songs featuring Riechmann's wordless chanting. Perhaps the strongest song is "Silberland," at once a chilly, alien-sounding arrangement and a stirring melody suggestive of a lost national anthem.

It's odd to think, though, that in the end Riechmann might best be remembered for Wunderbar's striking cover photo, with the musician covered in blue and white makeup that Gary Numan would later completely reuse for his Berserker album.
