






We started work on the 2nd volume back in November 2019 and originally scheduled to release it in mid-2020. The global pandemic created a huge amount of uncertainty around how to continue the label, and documenting the project on vinyl format was very close to being abandoned. For months it sat in a sort of limbo, but continued support on our other projects inspired us to make the decision to press forward with our original plan. In late 2020 we went to press and unfortunately had numerous issues with the vinyl factory + their stampers, forcing another difficult decision - to abandon the project with them, take a loss on the vinyl stampers and work on finding another factory.

Through the artist community we were able to find another spot that came through rather quickly, especially considering the delays around vinyl projects these days. We went back to press in March, and luckily all went smooth... We're thrilled to finally be able to release this!


This is an album of broken and obscured grandeur, partially incorporating heavily distressed classical music samples, in particular from Sergei Rachmaninov's piece, "All-Night igil". With it's dark echoes of early Doctor Who episodes, and it's bent and twisted, industrially tinged and distorted choral decay, it seems at times an ominous soundtrack to an end of the world sci-fi film.

Lina Filipovich is a Belarusian artist and musician based in Paris. Her works explore the relationship between audio and visuals and span a variety of media, including found footage films, experimental electronic music, painting, silkscreening and performance. Working with samples and loops, Lina Filipovich uses techniques of sound collage, musical montage, cut-up and appropriation.

Australian artist theAdelaidean's fourth solo release for Projekt takes the listener on an ambient journey through the worlds of water: oceans, rivers, lakes, and rain itself. Changeable yet changeless, the first half of this double album shows the evolution of theAdelaidean as a composer and performer. It blends electronics and field recordings in a five-movement symphony to the weather of modern life from untouched forests to busy cityscapes. A generated static energy captures nature's music for those moments when the nearest sun shower might be hours away or thunderstorms a distant memory. Layers of natural and urban sounds dance with muted melodic synths through timelessly crisp harmonic spaces rewarding deeper listens and backgrounding alike.

The final track, more than an hour of dark ambience, spirals deep into the kind of rain that comes when most of the world is asleep. Soft with an ever-changing rhythmic stillness, "Witching Hour Weather" is a calm companion for insomniacs and seekers of inner truths alike.

Composed and created in the midst of an Australian drought, SOUNDS LIKE RAIN is both a love song and a summoning spell for one of nature's most precious gifts.



This quest is painted with a wide array of styles: deep drones and ambient textures, classical counterpoint and driving polyrhythms, atonal sound painting and unabashed romanticism. The diverse sounds here are anchored by the flute-like timbre of the Haken Continuum Fingerboard synthesizer, which appears throughout as the knowledge-seeking protagonist. These richly layered soundscapes evoke the majesty of myth, from the cosmic arpeggios of "Higgs Field, Cauldron of Being" to the intimate pastoral of "The Still Small Voice."



Lisa Bella Donna is an internationally acclaimed recording artist, composer, modular synthesist, sound designer, educator, and clinician. She has decades of experience as a session musician, educator, as well as developing extensive techniques with musique concreté, modular synthesis, analog & digital recording techniques, microtonal music, orchestration & film composition.

Lisa currently tours all throughout the USA, Japan & Europe performing concerts and conducting workshops and clinics. She has been commissioned for many multichannel audio art installations in the USA and Europe. Lisa continues to inspire synthesists across the world every day from her recording studio in the Appalachian Mountains.



Dynamic, emotional, and filmic, this album further establishes Lisa Bella Donna as one of the living masters of synthesis.

Rather a story from someone who started on Moog synthesizers very young, about all of the doors it opened in my music and the way I looked at sound afterward. The one instrument that connected musicians and free-thinking artists of sound. All through my early years of working with Moog synthesizers, I would think about Bob's journey and process; how amazing and exciting it must have been dreaming of such far reaching ideas to be so fully realized so quickly. His instruments and his designs have everything to do with the way I compose and realize my own work. To be invited to collaborate on this record with The Bob Moog Foundation is a thing of miracles. It's also another beautiful way to celebrate the opening of the Moogseum, something I was so grateful to be a part of 2 years ago. I am hopeful that this record moves the listener through a series of chapters that gets them in touch with how they first discovered Moog synthesizers and the remarkable impact that they made."



The eclectic electro-experimental adventure begins with a nod to the first counter culture community we were a part of, The Grain, pays tribute to the cassette underground years and moves on to the new digital community we now exist within. The Magic Bullet are joined by friends; Shaun Robert (Institute For Alien Research), Neil Crud (On Tudno FM / Spam Javelin) and M.Nomized (Fraction Studio), plus very special guests from the golden age of Music & Elsewhere, Gypsy and Levente.

Levente (Levente Toth) is a United Kingdom-based synth artist and published photographer.Born in Transylvania's Hungarian ethnic minority, his main escapism during the communist dictatorship was listening to electronic music.

He built his first analogue synth when he was a teenager living under the Ceausescu regime. Music creation has really begun later on in his home studio, which he established after his relocation

His CDs released by the former PeopleSound and Vitaminic indie internet labels were noted for the compositional versatility, which created well-received blends of medieval, ethnic and space/ambient elements.

Making music has been in his blood since his childhood days. It made his parents decide that he should get some music education... So he learned to play guitar, flute, keyboards etc...

Thanks to a school friend (we're talking early 80's!) he learned about the synthesizer. Its endless sound capabilities changed his musical life completely. A bit later he and his cousin founded the electro/new wave band 'Another Season'. After that he decided to start a solo-project: Venja. Using a self built synthesizer and some other custom made equipment he released his first album 'Modesty'. Indeed a very modest album at that time.







Oversoul

Carl Matthews

Everything is alive.

Everything...

Everything is conscious.

Everything is connected.

Carl Matthews was one of the early pioneers in the UK electronic/synthesist movement, producing cassette releases via Mirage, Electronical Dreams and various compilations.

In spite of the irresistible urge felt by many to claim Matthews for the Berlin School, this is unquestionably an artist who wrote music far from the madding krautrock crowd. Instead, he worked in isolation, splendid or otherwise. The question remains, is there a suspension bridge which connects Carl Matthews to the mainland European tradition of Harmonia, Cluster, and Tangerine Dream? 'I was at a crossroads in my life aged 28, early influences were krautrock: NEU!, Kraftwerk, Cosmic Jokers, etc. One day, I was listening to Tim Blake, and my inner voice said "I can do that!", Carl recalls. Whilst his music clearly bears the hallmarks of superb craftsmanship -- his mesmerizing soundscapes more than a match for any of his contemporaries.

Carl Matthews was a truly independent artist, from the means of production to the published recordings. If it is possible to identify a scene along the lines described above, Matthews was not part of it. 'I was totally alone in doing this; no one was interested in my musical taste at that time. As far as I know the electronic/new wave music scene in Carlisle was virtually zero.' Happily for fans of his music, recent years have seen a resurgence in activity. Unwaveringly self-effacing, Carl Matthews continued to make music which was liberated from the constraints of ego, allowing one to wander the magnetic fields of his imagination. In his own words, he is 'an old guy who likes making sounds for library/production companies', which says it all, really. The signs are all there in Call For World Saviours, music which is both timeless and very much of its time, a disappearing act on the part of its creator whose character nevertheless resonated in every note. Carl died in 2019. R.I.P

City Of Dawn & Sherry Finzer

Sherry Finzer believes that music can heal. Listeners contact her daily to let her know how much her music helps them in physical/mental healing, tinnitus, stress relief, and overall well-being.

She is a Phoenix-based flutist, performer, and composer, and runs Heart Dance Records – a label consisting of artists with a focus on healing music. Whether creating ethereal music for Spas, or more upbeat melodies for road trips, her magical tones are created by "low flute" instruments, of which include the alto, bass, and contrabass flutes., as well as Native and World flutes.

Sherry's newest solo flute release, "Renewal", has received global airplay and was recorded at The Tank in Rangely, CO. Other 2021 releases include singles with pianists Greg Maroney, Joseph Akins, and Cathy Oakes.

You can hear Sherry's music in regular rotation on the SXM Spa Channel, Music Choice, and multiple US and International airlines.

City of Dawn is an ambient project of Damien Duque from McAllen, TX. He creates Immersive and atmospheric melodic dreamy soundscapes. Aside from his mind-opening message about the effects of Ambient Music, his art also advocates for people within the Autism Spectrum. For Damien, his music is a way of dealing with occasional anxiety attacks, Depression, and Insomnia and through it he shares his experience as a person with Asperger's Syndrome (High Functioning Autism). Any City Of Dawn Album from Damien Duque will invite you into a meditational estate that is self-exploring, which journey he teaches us, can lead toward healing. Healing from our often cluttered mind, which is like the noise that surrounds us, disorganized and arbitrary, and help us align, whence discover meaning and what he calls 'Stillness". Quietness, Silence, and Tranquility. His Mission is to spread awareness acceptance of autism is set on the following goal; that people under the Autism Spectrum can do unique things and that Autism doesn't define, each individual defines Autism and themselves. Because it's not a disability, but rather a different ability. His Music is a testimony that Autism doesn't stop him from reaching his success and also it brings a listening experience that is transcendent. He loves to bring people (Listeners) together to meditate and experience the sounds.

Solace is a place of comfort during distress - it is the moment where the process of healing becomes a foundation for new beginnings.

City Of Dawn collaborates with Sherry Finzer to create a space for calmness and restoration in their new ambient album - Solace.

As Damien says: "Everyone has their own solace, and when listening to this album the listener unfolds the possibility of crafting their own narrative' Damien (aka City of Dawn).

Richard P John

"What interests me about ambient music is its ability to prolong a single state of emotion and thought for long periods of time in a way that many other genres can't."

Richard P John was born in Neath, South Wales in 1981 where he still lives. He studied piano and composition at the Royal College of Music and now works as a pianist, composer and teacher. His compositions are varied, ranging from solo piano music, choral and ensemble works to experimental and ambient music.

Glimpse is among the first of Richard's ambient works. Despite the seemingly static nature of the piece, each part/layer follows a slightly different tempo and/or time signature to each other. If we only 'glimpse' at the work, nothing appears to happen, but delve deeper inside and nothing actually ever stays the same.

"Stillness and silence are often filled with many more events than we at first notice. Glimpse is an attempt to make as seemingly static a piece as possible, while a closer look (or listen!), reveals a lot more happening than initially appears."

Marconi Union

Strata is the first single from the album 'Signals' and it sees Marconi Union diving headfirst into a new expansion of their sound.

"Strata is a rare example, for us, of a track that we tried out live a few times before committing to the album version" Duncan Meadows explains. "It's one of the most up-tempo pieces we've ever written, it has an energy and emotion which for us borders on elation."

Jamie Crossley adds that "Once we changed the rhythm pattern to this track, it took on a totally different feel, giving it more tension and suspense, I could imagine it being like a modern-day version of the sort of music used in those 60/70's crime/thriller soundtracks like 'Bullitt'".

And Richard Talbot adds a final piece of colour about the new track, saying "Strata has a sense of unworldliness for me, bringing together elements from different styles of music to create a combination of urgency and melancholy



Pjusk

"Ambient music. Watching the delicate tapestry of life. To sit quietly in an endless night."

Pjusk is Jostein Dahl Gjelsvik, who hails from the west coast of Norway.


The Pjusk sound is inspired by the harsh Norwegian weather and its wild landscapes. At the heart of the creative process is an old cabin way up high up in the mountains where most of the music is made - framed by snowy peaks and accompanied by the sound of icy cold streams.

Beautifully produced free-flowing glitchy downtempo electronica, cello-like mountaintop calls and shimmering celestial piano (a la Boards of Canada) all interwoven with the ghostly magic of Anne Garner's mesmeric voice, 'Turn Back' is the first single from the new EP 'One Place To Another' which The Ambient Zone will be releasing in September.

Reminiscent a little instrumentally perhaps in part with the music of Air, 'Turn Back' remains distinctively and uniquely Pjusk, with an ending that does in fact turn us back to the beginning where this unique Norwegian landscape joins us all together in a vast musical space.

GRAMMY® winning flutist Wouter Kellerman and 4-time GRAMMY® nominee David Arkenstone were inspired to explore their shared musical interests by combining their creativity and expressiveness in a joint project. Kellerman thrives on experimenting with the shades, textures and colours of the flute, and creatively blending them with other instrumentation and vocal sounds. Over the course of nine albums, Kellerman has steadfastly built on the rigorous classical training of his youth, to create a signature sound that's earned him both critical praise and multiple awards. He has won a total of eight SAMA's (South African Music Award, the SA equivalent to the American GRAMMY®), reinforcing his status as one of South Africa's foremost musicians.

David Arkenstone brings a bit of magic to every project he does. That, along with over 30 years of experience and knowledge working in the film and music industries, 4 Grammy nominations, 22 Billboard hits and over 65 albums in release makes David one of the most prolific and established composers of our time.

This world-renowned multi-instrumentalist has captivated audiences since he broke onto the scene in 1987 with his debut album, Valley in the Clouds. David's distinctive tracks are unique fusions of cinematic rock, classical and world music which create "soundscapes for your imagination."
