Hirough wetland, winters, rubble and fallout come horizons new; civilisation shattered under a vengeful cataclysm, eventually led to dawn from the light of a blighted leader. Every action has a reaction, and those who wish to prosper must first be willing to offer something of intrinsic value. As one empire crumbles, another takes its place. The struggle for a fleeting utopia comes at a cost, and those who strive towards golden gates must trek along a solemn valley.



Berlin-based artist, The Allegorist, has been meandering through stories with her purposeful and introspective take on electronic music. Each release explores themes that require joint participation from the listener as they look to floodyour mind with images of fabled characters and places through her artistic soundscapes. Her carefully build worlds that straddle sci-fi and fantasy, feeding off of the light and dark dualism are the perfect blend of reflective contemplation and storytelling.

As a holistic artist, Anna Jordan (The Allegorist) encapsulates a myriad of her talents within her work

Electronic music allows her to combine groove with the beauty of the freely unfolding form and thereby realizing her very own expression. The album "Andersworld" (2020) released by the label Broque is the second in a series of albums based on the poems of Scottish poet Robert Louis Stevenson. Marie's conceptual thinking and her craft as a modern classical composer allow her to congenially translate his lyrics into a modern electronic language, which is influenced by techno and electronica

Trained in a variety of musical and instrumental styles since her early childhood, Marie Wilhelmine Anders received her first technical training as a sound engineer. Her affinity for microphones, cables and last but not least the cutting of music stems from this time. In 1989, at the age of nineteen, she was a member of the East Berlin underground scene as a keyboarder. She studied music at the universities in Berlin and Stuttgart, where she was an active member of the improvised and experimental music scene until 2005. During this time, in addition to her solo activities, she founded two ensembles - Unterton and Hammerhaus - which brought together groove and free-flowing improvised forms from different perspectives. She initiated and directed "momentmusik" - a "concert series for experimental and improvised music, visual arts, performance and language" at the "Theater Rampe Stuttgart", which established the connection between her ensembles and the national and international scene. In 2005 she ended her concert activity, went back to Berlin and started producing her music with Cubase. Since 2009 she publishes her music under the pseudonym Marie Wilhelmine Anders.

Delphine Tesla was born in Strasbourg, in the region of Alsace Lorraine, France, and came to America from Cannes already a skilled electronic music composer, piano player and keyboardist. Since first locating in Hollywood, she made great strides in developing and expanding her skills, thanks to personal manager/producer, actor, Bud Mathis – eventually becoming the accomplished composer and music programmer that she is today!

Eko Lunae: Relaxing ambient music for peace of mind with beautiful strings, mysterious pianos and luscious pads. Promotes relaxation of mind and body for a wonderful restful sleep. Etherial bells, chimes and atmospheric sounds also make "EKO" a must have album for yoga and meditation

Delphine was also a background singer, keyboard player and composer for eclectic alternative rock band Cybjörn aka Björn Means Bear. She is currently a Platinum Award-winning musical artist, winning much accolades for her work on Selena's hit album "Dreaming of You" (a combination of Spanish-language songs and new English-language tracks) which debuted at #1 on the U.S. Billboard 200, making Selena the first Hispanic performer to accomplish this feat. Delphine has also worked on other albums with legendary Guy Roche, producer of many hit artists such as Christina Aguilera, Aaliyah, Gladys Knight, Natasha Bedingfield, Brandy and Cher.

MEGBOWLES PILGRIMAGE

Meg's newest CD, Pilgrimage (2022), explores a more cinematic ambient-orchestral style that incorporates spacious atmospheric textures evoking meteorological phenomena and other poetic elements that form an accompanying dreamscape along the path of a life journey.

In addition to receiving airplay on various syndicated programs such as Echoes and Music from the Hearts of Space, Meg's work has appeared on several compilation albums - The Other World (Hypnos Recordings 1998), Soundscape Gallery 2 (Lektronic Soundscapes, 1998), and two albums released by the Mindful Music Association - A Better Life (2019) and Focus Zone - Music for Studying (2021). megbowlesmusic.com megbowlesmusic.bandcamp.com



Connecticut based composer-synthesist Meg Bowles (b.1957) began her musical journey as flutist and completed formal studies in classical music performance at both Northwestern and Boston Universities. She earned an M.B.A. in finance from Columbia University in 1984 and worked as a derivatives trader for a number of years before leaving the field to pursue advanced studies in Jungian psychology and to create ambient electronic music.

Meg's first two CDs, Inner Space and Solstice Dreams, were released in 1993, followed by critically-acclaimed Blue Cosmos in 1996. Her musical association with David Bilger, Principal Trumpet of the Philadelphia Orchestra, resulted in several commissioned works for trumpet and fixed media. The first of these commissions, Night Sun Journey, was premiered by Mr. Bilger at the 1996 International Trumpet Guild Brassfest, followed by the premiere of Places Where Rivers Meet at Washington National Cathedral in 1997. These pieces and other works for trumpet and fixed media are included in her CD From the Dark Earth (1999), with David Bilger as the featured soloist.

Meg's fifth CD, A Quiet Light (2011) - a collection of six contemplative ambient works which explore reflections of the numinous in nature - was followed by two awardwinning releases, The Shimmering Land (2013), and Evensong: Canticles for the Earth (2018), the latter a meditative reflection upon the ritual spaces of evening. Both albums were voted Best Ambient Album by Zone Music Reporter.

Sunergy brings together Kaitlyn Aurelia Smith and Suzanne Ciani synthesists for the thirteenth install of FRKWYS, RVNG Intl.'s intergenerational collaboration series.

For this edition, a panorama of the Pacific Coast provides the place and headspace for exploratory Buchla synthesizer passages that meditate on a life-giving form vast and volatile with change.

The LP version includes a printed inner sleeve and a high-quality digital album download. LP and CD versions include the bonus track "Retrograde."

For some electronic musicians, the sound is primarily a formal or aesthetic concern; for Kaitlyn Aurelia Smith, it's spiritual. The music she makes with her Buchla modular synthesizer extends her yoga practice: a means of self-knowledge, a way of finding a balance between mind, body, and the world around her. The Bolinas, California, musician calls the album "my expression of love and appreciation for electricity" that is, an attempt to channel vibrations into a shape both resonant and meaningful. She composed the album as part of a daily practice of physical movement, and it shows: Unlike drone-based ambient, which puts its focus on static tones,

Suzanne is a five-time Grammy award-nominated composer, electronic music pioneer, and neo-classical recording artist who has released over 20 solo albums including "Seven Waves," and "The Velocity of Love," along with a landmark quad LP "LIVE Quadraphonic," which restarted her Buchla modular performances. Her work has been featured in films, games, and countless commercials as well.

She was inducted into the first class of Keyboard Magazine's Hall of Fame alongside other synth luminaries, including Bob Moog, Don Buchla and Dave Smith and received the Moog Innovation Award. Most recently, she is the recipient of the Independent Icon Award from A2IM.







TRANSMISSIONS FROM THE SECRET CINEMA LIFE IS A VICNIC





Located at an unsuspect basement somewhere in the coastal town of Aveiro, a certain underground auditorium was built in 1969 to support the local dissemination of censored and forbidden artworks. During the Portuguese dictatorship, it operated as a clandestine cinema and cultural headquarters for the local opposition to the regime.

From the depths of the house where the multifaceted artist and social activist Vasco Branco (1919-2014) once lived and worked, this secret cinema has recently recovered its original role as a safe harbour for mystics, artists and outsiders, while continuously hosting exploratory music, independent cinema, poetry and audiovisual performance.

This compilation features an odd collection of mostly unpublished tracks from artists whose work we feel strongly about and who have performed live at our underground auditorium over the past few years. The first volume of Transmissions from the Secret Cinema also marks the official debut of VIC NIC, our freshly baked circulatory device for sonic, visual and written artworks.

On the backroads of DIY culture, we will keep pushing this sanctuary for the wild at heart towards the edification of possible shared futures, by openly facilitating the flight plans for time travel artefacts. We hope you join us.

Past Inside the Present (PITP) is an American ambient label focusing on offering up some of the very best ambient, drone, soundscape, and minimal music by passionate artists from across the globe.

"The Other Side of Darkness' is a collaborative album from 36 and awakened souls. The project began with James (awakened souls) sending Dennis (36) a few bass loops he made and quickly evolved into a collaborative project with Cynthia (awakened souls) as well.

In addition to the main album, the artists also wrote their accompanying versions of the entire The Other Side of Darkness album, essentially turning the main album into three unique interpretations. All tracks are collected into one extended long-play for the digital version.

The 'After Dark" versions by 36 revisions The Other Side of Darkness into a rain-drenched neo-noir, reflecting on the bleak backdrop of a challenging year. It is a highly emotional, deeply personal work written to be played continuously from beginning to end.

The 'Other' versions by awakened souls uncover the numerous sides of the Gemini husband/wife duo, James and Cynthia. Ranging from deep drone, dub and acid to compositional ambient and shoegaze, this album traverses many moods. Muzan Editions is a small label from Osaka, Japan, focusing on ambient and experimental sound.





Mareena developed her musical career in synchronicity with the steady advancement of techno and house after growing up in the GDR where techno emerged in the '90s. As a result of her experiences within the diverse musical landscape of Berlin, she has developed her own distinct sensibility for musical narrative. This evolution led naturally to DJ gigs in many notable venues and o rganisations such as Berghain, About Blank, Griessmühle, De School, Tangent Gallery in Detroit during Movement Festival, The Bunker New York, Monasterio Moscow, IfZ and most prominently her residency at Tresor since 2012.



Primarily a live performer, JakoJako makes extensive use of modular synthesis in her productions and on stage. "Depending on how you configure your system, you can design a completely different instrument every time. I love when it's surprising me." When not in the studio, her expertise is put to use advising well-established artists on their own systems at Berlin's synth-mecca SchneidersLaden.




Atlas der Gedanken

Mareena & JakoJako

On "Atlas der Gedanken" we witness Mareena, curator of Berlin's ambient label Unrush, and modular powerhouse JakoJako, two talented musicians and friends, embark on a joyful voyage through sound. A feeling of nostalgia emerges, evoked by the euphoria-inducing synth melodies of "Phantasma" and "Sinnessprung"; echoing the slowly fading memories of past dancefloors. What follows is the album's focal point "Mut zur Wahrheit", a dense and lavishly layered monolith of a song, and we find ourselves fully immersed in an all captivating wall of sound.

Rays of hope shimmer through the oscillating sequencers and polyrhythmic pulsations on "Tagtraum" and "Neue Impulse", letting us dream of better days to come. With the closing track "Wandel", radiating a seemingly effortless serenity, this sonic adventure reaches its calm and soothing end.

As a composer and performer of acoustic and electroacoustic music, Sarah Davachi's (b. 1987, Canada) work is concerned with the close intricacies of timbral and temporal space, utilizing extended durations and simple harmonic structures that emphasize subtle variations in texture, overtone complexity, psychoacoustic phenomena, and temperament and intonation. The instrumentation she employs is varied, including electric organ, pipe and reed organ, tape-replay samplers, voice and choir, analog synthesizers, piano, and both modern and early strings, brass, and woodwinds. Similarly informed by minimalist and long-form tenets, baroque leanings toward slowmoving chordal suspension, and experimental production practices of the recording studio environment, in her sound is manifest an intimate and patient experience that lessens perceptions of the familiar and the distant.

Living Torch, through its unique structural form and harmonic material, is a bold continuation of Kali Malone's demanding and exciting body of work, while opening new perspectives and increasing the emotional potential of the music tenfold. As such, Living Torch is a major new piece by the composer and adds a significant milestone to an already fascinating repertoire.

Departing from the pipe organ that Malone's music is most notable for, Living Torch features a complex electroacoustic ensemble. Leafing through recordings from conventional instruments like the trombone and bass clarinet to more experimental machines like the boîte à bourdon, passing through sinewave generators and Éliane Radigue's ARP 2500 synthesizer. Living Torch weaves its own history, its own genealogy, and that of its author. It extends her robust structural approach to a liberated palette of timbre.

Living Torch was initially commissioned by GRM for its legendary loudspeaker orchestra, the Acousmonium, and premiered in its complete multichannel form at the Grand Auditorium of Radio France in a concert entirely dedicated to the artist.







Headphone Commute is an independent online magazine covering electronic, experimental and instrumental music. Since 2007 the site has been featuring album reviews, artist interviews, label profiles, music festivals, and an award-winning podcast.

This colossal compilation of 89 tracks was curated by Headphone Commute to benefit all of those affected by Hurricane Sandy, the largest Atlantic hurricane on record, which has devastated portions of the Caribbean, Mid-Atlantic and Northeastern United States in late October 2012. 100% of all the proceeds generated from the sale of this album will be donated towards two charitable organizations: Doctors Without Borders and The Humane Society. The artists on the release have been hand-picked to showcase the world's top talent in ambient, modern classical, and experimental music. The unprecedented selection features many unreleased pieces composed exclusively for the cause.

Her appearances on radio stations like XT3 techno radio, Radio 538, Deep FM, and KLIKKmusic, her sets on a variety of parties in and outside Holland (Italy, Berlin, Brussel) and remixes she did for Snejl, Wide Angle Recordings, Rezongar, Inlab Recordings and Manual Music recently are proof examples of the recognition of her unique style.

Hania Rani is a pianist, composer and musician who, was born in Gdansk and splits her life between Warsaw, where she makes her home, and Berlin. The now-iconic 'Live from Studio S2' memorizing performance gets a sought after limited vinyl edition and now features all four tracks from the session including the previously unreleased 'Hawaii Oslo' and 'Glass' which will also be available to stream and download. First premiered on the Gondwana Records YouTube channel on Sunday, March 28th 2021 at 8:00 PM / 9:00 PM CET, it has since become a global success reaching 3 million views and counting and has earned Rani many more devoted fans.


Live from Studio S2 Warsaw

At the beginning of February 2021, I was invited by the Berlinale Film Festival to record a live set as a part of the EFM sessions which became the motivation to document this live performance.

I thought that bringing back my piano and equipment to the hall where I first recorded my live session videos for my debut album 'Esja' would be a nice idea and the right cinematic choice. This time, I wanted to use not only an upright piano but also a grand piano and some other keyboards including a Prophet 08 synthesizer and a Roland stage piano.









PENELOPE REDEUX

On 'Redeux' 'Penelope Two's' themes of life and death and of hope and dismay are still prevalent, being brought to the surface in a myriad of ways. Scottish post-rock legends Mogwai stretch out 'Burn On' into a scorching, warbling drone that flips the original sombre subtlety for grandeur and in-your-face majesty. Factory Floor member Nik Colk Void offers up a wayward, statically charged reworking of 'Nite Hive' which reimagines the track's solemn beauty as a heads down roller and Throbbing Gristle's Cosey Fanni Tutti's dystopian, avant-garde and jazz tinged electronics are deployed alongside her signature Cornet to flip the album single 'Carry Me'.


Penelope Trappes, is a London based vocalist, musician and ethereal soundscaper originally from the Northern Rivers of NSW, Australia.

PENELOPE TRAPPES

Gnostic State references a world punctuated with mercurial and arcane moments. Expansive space, mentally and musically, makes way for what at first seem like imperceptible turns: hints of voice, breath, plants, synths, field recordings of relatives and of myself in my studio. All become part of an unpredictable and far-reaching sphere. I felt very free focusing in and creating this in one day — it truly felt like a microcosm of life as we try to find universal knowledge in all daily happenings, looking for links between incident and reason.




Inspired by the true story of Laika, a stray dog sent into space by Soviet Russia in the fifties, Perpetual Journey speaks of the emotional journeys and strange fates that entangle our lives. An intoxicating ascent into the upper atmosphere and beyond, Strië's collagic style is profoundly felt on these six compositions; fragments of sound layer up to create an ever deepening sound stage, bound together with layers of static and hiss. Perpetual Journey is another irresistible invitation to spend time with Striē in the immersive, introspective world she inhabits.

Olga Wojciechowska is a Polish composer and multi-instrumentalist whose work drifts between modern classical and electronic music. Her compositions are frequently sought out by acclaimed directors and choreographers for dance, theatre and visual projects. Olga's commissioned work includes music for Royal Opera House, Sidi Larbi Cherkaoui, Yabin Wang, Oslo Opera House among others.

She released 2 solo albums Maps and Mazes (2015) and Infinite Distances (2019). Her music has been featured in compilations published by Ninja Tune, Traum Schallplatten, Sonic Cathedral and Hibernate.





More Than Just A Dream

Every portrait that is painted with feeling is a portrait of the artist, not of the sitter.



After years spent performing and recording with other artists and groups, Canadian-born, New York City-based Julia Kent found her own voice with her solo debut, Delay, an exploration of the private emotional worlds that exist within the disjunctions and disorientations of travel, hailed for its "lovely, melancholy" compositions, full of "aching romanticism...rich melodicism, and detailed arrangements." She toured to support it throughout Europe and North America, and subsequently released an EP, Last Day in July.

In Green and Grey, her following solo record, she continued to use looped and layered cello, electronics, and field recordings to explore the intersections between the human world and the natural world, the melding of the technological and the organic, the patterns and repetitions that exist in nature and are mirrored in human creations, and the complexity and fragility of our relationships with one another and with the world that surrounds us.

Temporal her latest work is a meditation on the transitory and fragile nature of existence.

Much of the music that comprises the album was originally written to accompany theatre and dance productions. "The initial inspiration was more external than internal, in that many of these pieces began as a response to a text or a choreographic concept," Julia explains, "but they all seemed to be coming from the same emotional world and it made sense to weave them together into a record."

After the threat of violent release on previous album Asperities, Temporal's relationship to the physical world manifests itself in a more organic, human sound. The electronic manipulations are subtler, with Julia sampling voices from a theatre production and processing them into unrecognisable textures: ghosts of the source material. "I included the processed voices to acknowledge the genesis of the music and also because I wanted to incorporate vocals in a way that turned voice into texture, and blurred the lines between sonic elements."







Connections is the third solo flute release in Sherry Finzer's "Naked Flute" series, recorded at The Tank.

Inspired by the imaginings of the legendary Paul Horn, this album is a peaceful compilation of improvisations recorded for 16 people who use Sherry's music on a regular basis for dealing with pain and loss, stress relief, relaxation, and physical ailments such as tinnitus and Meniere's disease.

Born from her connections with listeners during her live streams on the Insight Timer app, and learning about the participants' life experiences, all songs were either created in memory of loved ones who have passed, or for someone who currently uses Sherry's music daily to help in healing.

Besides composing and recording, Sherry is the founder and CEO of the Heart Dance Records label featuring musicians from around the world with a mission of creating music for peace and wellness. She is also founder of the Higher Level Media promotions company which focuses on radio promotions for New Age and Contemporary Instrumental artists. Sherry was one of the three founding members of the Mindful Music Association and currently sits on the board of directors for The Tank
