
With the DiN label celebrating its 25th anniversary, it's perhaps important to remember that one of the founding principles of the imprint was to encourage musical collaborations between different artists. Indeed, label boss Ian Boddy has previously collaborated with eight separate musicians, including such luminaries as Robert Rich, Erik Wøllo, Chris Carter, Markus Reuter and Mark Shreeve (as ARC). Thus, when the UK-based Awakenings electronic music concert series invited Boddy to perform a gig alongside Dave Bessell, an opportunity arose for a new, untried musical collaboration.



The second piece begins with unusual, piquant harmonic progressions from Bessell overlaid with pizzicato percussion. A lengthy, extended sequencer follows, again meticulously constructed by Boddy and his arsenal of modular synths. While Bessell provides an arc of ever-rising chordal pads, Boddy continuously twists and turns the ostinato patterns as this section rises to a monumental sonic climax.

Following such hectic, rhythmic textures, the duo opts for a gentle, blissful encore, with each artist improvising against each other with warm, analogue chords and pads.

Polarity again illuminates the fantastic opportunities collaborations can offer, especially in a live performance where each artist has to play, listen to, and respond to the other performer.

Behind his characteristic mane of hair lies an artist who has been an active and creative creator for over forty years. THE STRATOMUSICA SUITE

Due to the computer and software revolution of the last two decades, it is now almost possible to "touch the sky." Although flying into space or having one's own satellite is still reserved for very few individuals or companies, now a group of enthusiasts or even a single person can send electronics into the stratosphere.

Up there, 20 or 30 km above sea level, the conditions are similar to "outer space": the pressure is almost zero, the temperature is chilling 50 degrees below zero, there is a higher radiation level, the horizon is curved, and the sky is almost completely black. It is called "near space", and one can reach it employing a balloon filled with helium or hydrogen.


The STRATOMUSICA mission is an idea to send a dozen cameras into "near space," providing a full 360-degree view, including up and down. The plan is to show the view of the Earth from the stratosphere, as close as it could look to the human eye. But without music, it would be just a "raw" sight, empty of the human desire to reach out into the vast space beyond our planet. After all, where does our future lie but in space?

Robert Scott Thompson and Erdem Helvacioğlu




Robert Scott Thompson

The term musical alchemist best describes modern music composer Robert Scott Thompson. Combining his mastery of the electroacoustic, contemporary instrumental, and avant-garde genres into a swirling cohesive whole, he is an important pioneer in music's new frontier. Hailed as one of the most important composers working in electroacoustic, acousmatic and classical ambient music today, he has produced and published seminal work since 1976.



Robert's music can be heard in influences as diverse as Chopin and Satie, Stockhausen, Varèse and Cage, and Bowie and Eno. Although his first love is the electronic music synthesizer, Robert is also an expressive vocalist, instrumentalist, video artist, computer musician, sound designer, and film composer.

He has created work in various forms ranging from chamber and orchestral music to works for the virtuoso soloist, electroacoustic music, and video and performance art. He is the recipient of several prizes and distinctions for his music; including the First Prize in the 2003 Musica Nova Competition (Czech Republic), the First Prize in the 2001 Pierre Schaeffer Competition (Italy).



Erdem Helvacio**ğ**lu

The first commercial release to feature Erdem's music was the self-titled debut album by symphonic rock band Too Much. Erdem was a founding member, guitar player and songwriter for Too Much. The album was recorded and released into Istanbul's underground music scene in 1993 while Erdem was still in high school.

Erdem began composing electronic music pieces while he was studying electroacoustic music composition and sound engineering at Istanbul Technical University. He has composed music for various film, theatre, and multimedia productions with the release of his debut album, "Altered Realities", in 2006 as an electronic music artist. For his work on the movie Poyraz, which was chosen for the 2006 Cannes Film Festival, he received "The Best Original Soundtrack" award at the 2007 Mostramundo Film Festival.


Besides his electronic musician and film composer work, Erdem also produces for and performs with the Turkish rock band Rashit. He most recently appeared in the Rock'N Coke festival in Istanbul in September 2007, featuring Chris Cornell, Smashing Pumpkins, and Manic Street Preachers.





Since its release in 1988, Dreamtime Return has earned its reputation as a genuine classic. The two-CD magnum opus is one of the most important, widely known and highly respected release in Steve Roach's vast body of work. It serves as an essential benchmark within the Electronic-Ethno-Atmospheric genre.

Roach's travels in the Australian outback, along with studies of the Aboriginal Dreamtime, and his desert walkabouts in California were the lifeblood for this recording which even today sounds like a transmission from the near future and the very distant past.



Three decades after its release, the true expansive depth of this iconic masterpiece has been meticulously unveiled, revealing a refined listening experience. With this 30th Anniversary High Definition remastered edition, mastering engineer Howard Givens utilizes his years of technical knowledge with electronic music, an extensive array of analog and digital tools, and his passion for this seminal work, to restore the original sonic nature and visionary intention, taking the listener deeper into the dreamtime.





Deep listening is a practice and concept rooted in attentively and empathetically engaging with sounds, people, and the environment. It goes beyond mere hearing and involves a profound, holistic experience of sound and communication. The term is often associated with the following contexts:

- 1. Music and Sound: In music, deep listening was popularised by composer Pauline Oliveros, who described it as an aesthetic based on embracing the full spectrum of sounds, including silence, and being fully present with the auditory experience. Oliveros founded the Deep Listening Institute, which promotes the practice through workshops and retreats focusing on meditative listening exercises and sound awareness.
- 2. Interpersonal Communication: In the realm of communication, deep listening involves actively and empathetically engaging with another person, fully focusing on what they are saying without interrupting, judging, or formulating a response prematurely. This type of listening fosters understanding, connection, and trust.
- 3. Mindfulness and Meditation: Deep listening can be a mindfulness practice where one pays attention to sounds in the environment or within oneself. This involves awareness of the layers of sound, the space between sounds, and the emotional and physical reactions to these sounds.

Principles of Deep Listening 1. Attention: Fully concentrate on the present moment, minimising distractions and giving undivided attention to the sound or speaker.

2. Empathy: Engage with an open heart to understand and connect with the emotions and


- 2. Empathy: Engage with an open heart to understand and connect with the emotions and intentions behind the sounds or words.
- 3. Non-judgment: Listen without immediate evaluation or criticism, allowing the sounds or messages to exist as they are.
- 4. Reflection: After listening, reflect on what was heard to deepen understanding and integrate the experience.

Practices and Techniques 1. Sound Walks: Taking walks to listen to the environment, noting different layers and sources of sound.

- 2. Body Awareness: Paying attention to how sounds resonate within the body, noting any physical sensations or emotional responses.
- 3. Listening Exercises: Structured activities that focus on specific listening skills, such as identifying distant sounds, listening to silence, or focusing on a single sound source.
- 4. Mindful Conversation: Practicing deep listening in dialogue by giving full attention to the speaker, pausing before responding, and reflecting back on what was heard.

Benefits of Deep Listening

- Enhanced Awareness: Increases sensitivity to soundscapes and auditory details, enriching the sensory experience. Improved Relationships: Fosters better communication and deeper connections with others. Emotional Regulation: Can help manage stress and emotions by promoting mindfulness and present-moment awareness.
- Creative Inspiration: Often used by artists and musicians to inspire creativity and new perspectives. In its various forms, deep listening encourages a richer, more attentive experience of the world, enhancing both personal and interpersonal understanding and connection. IvanB





Bella Donna released her first solo work in 1994. In 2019, she released 10 full-length albums, which she has described as an "instant composition" approach to reflect the nature of the live performances. In 2019, she also released a four-way split with Boris, Relaxer, and Crypt City, with a brief tour in Japan. By mid-2021, she had released 25 albums. [According to Dave Segal of The Stranger, "her Bandcamp is full of outstanding releases", referring to her collection of works released on Bandcamp, and her "arsenal includes some of the most glorious-sounding instruments in the electronic-music spectrum: ARP 2600, ARP String Ensemble, Moog One, and Moog Modular System."

Bella Donna is one of the featured artists interviewed for the 2020 book PATCH & TWEAK with Moog by Kim Bjørn. She is a Moog Music representative, was featured in a 2019 promotional video for the Matriarch synthesizer, and has demonstrated Moog instruments in a 2019 video for Reverb.

Her home recording studio, Appalachian Recording, is based in the Appalachians.






Christian Fiesel Radium Girls

Every sound has its own story. And each story can be completely different. That said, Christian Fiesel is trying to cross all borders of electronic and experimental music. His interest is not about being into a specific genre but to dare anything at least just once.

This is the aftermath of a more significant project, which started as a collaboration with Rocco Müller as FM.tronica about the aftermath of Chernobyl, Ukraine, in 1986. We collected tons of ideas, and as often, a lot of pieces didn't were discussed further for various reasons. This is where the idea for this album began. I collected tons of ideas and little miniatures. A bit in the style of my musical forefather Roedelius, the small bits assembled into a more outstanding picture concerning the aftereffects of radiation.

The Radium Girls were female factory workers who contracted radiation poisoning from painting radium dials watch dials and hands with self-luminous paint. The incidents occurred at three factories in the United States: one in Orange, New Jersey, beginning around 1917; one in Ottawa, Illinois, beginning in the early 1920s; and one in Waterbury, Connecticut, also in the 1920s.

For a sense of freedom and floating, Weightless is an EP that will take you on a dreamlike journey with ambient pads and textures for a calm and relaxing sense of discovery.
