Remarkably, it's been more than 40 years since we started making electronic music together as teenagers. To mark this anniversary, we attempted to produce a set of pieces using similar equipment and compositional approaches. This album is the result.

All the tracks were produced with a limited set of instruments, mostly contemporary copies of the synths we used back in the 1980s. Although the originals were sold long ago, these instruments are now somehow viewed as 'classics' and have consequently been reproduced either in hardware or software form by modern manufacturers. Remarkably, we could reconstruct our original studio set-up based around the Korg Polysix, Sequential Circuits Pro One, Moog Prodigy, Roland SH101 and Roland Tr606 (x 2).

Following our 1980's workflow, all of these pieces were improvised live, then overdubbed with a second layer of live performance. We also attempted to revisit that particular flavour of 'Berlin School' synth music that prevailed for a few years at the start of the 1980s, influenced by artists such as Tangerine Dream, Mark Shreeve, Ashra, Harald Grosskopf, Wolfgang Duren etc. In other words, a style featuring plenty of analogue synth sequences, together with drum machines and synth melodies.

The album and track titles reflect the location where we recorded these sessions—a rented barn on the edge of the New Forest National Park.

Our idea was to create an album that might be considered a follow-up to 'Daquise', which we released in 1985. So this is unashamedly an exercise in nostalgia for us. We hope you enjoy our attempt at time travel.

While Michael was working on the Beyond Chaos project in Germany, he and Christian would set up studios in hotel rooms to work on their album.



On one trip, while passing a large blue billboard at a tram stop in Frankfurt, they saw words printed in large white letters.


Sounds Searching for People sounds searching for the right persons for their expression rather than vice versa. The words stuck and thus came the name for the album.


German musician Frank Dorittke, also known as F.D. Project, is originally a guitarist from the Dinslaken-based band Imagine.

He became interested in electronic music around 1991, influenced by the works of Tangerine Dream ("Stratosfear") and Jean Michel Jarre.

Frank couldn't resist diving deep into the genre and started composing his own electronic music, which ultimately led to his debut album, "Electronic Dreams." To his own astonishment, F.D. Project was awarded "Best Newcomer" at Schallwende and the German Schwingungen Wahl 2003, and in the following years, he received other honors at the same event. In 2004, he released "Blue Vision," which featured fine electric guitar complementing his electronic compositions. That same year, he performed his first live concerts and placed third as "Best Electronic Musician" at Schallwende, while "Blue Vision" was recognized as the second "Best" CD at the same venue. In the subsequent years, more successful CDs and DVDs were released.

Frank also offered a free downloadable album through Pharmacom Records under the moniker "Mare Tranquillitatis." This double album pays a wonderful tribute to the old Berlin-School, delivering over two hours of groovy, rhythmic, and quite cinematic music. The expertly played electric guitar plays a significant role here, reminiscent of parts from Tangerine Dream's "Encore" and some vintage work by Pink Floyd.

The versatile and accessible music of F.D. Project is not so easy to categorize, as his influences range from Tangerine Dream to Mike Oldfield, often blending elements of the Berlin School and guitar riffs. At times, it can be melodic and up-tempo, then shift to captivating atmospheric textures and soundscapes. However, during live performances, one can always expect to hear some impressive guitar playing.



Seven years after the release of their celestial The Moon Viewing Garden EP (Sett Records, 2018), Mercury's Antennae have re-emerged with their latest offering of sonic lullabies, Among the Black Trees. Nine existential tales inhabit a ghostly realm of reflection, rebirth and reconciliation, overlaying dense bass, swirling ghostly guitars, and atmospheric electronics, all melding with lustrous and soaring vocal melodies.

Currently based between Geneva, Switzerland, and Portland, Oregon, in the US, the trio comprises Dru Allen (This Ascension), Cindy Coulter (This Ascension, Faith and the Muse), and Erick R. Scheid (The Palace of Tears). Their sound incorporates influences from shoegaze pop, ethereal darkwave, and unadorned acoustic beauty, often compared to 90s-era Projekt artists, while also drawing inspiration from modern ambient electronica.

MERCURY'S ANTENNAE THE REFLECTING SKIN William Faith Remix

The album casts a shimmering light on the earthly tale of a scorched and blackened wilderness, lonely yet peaceful, kept in stillness from a violent death of fire and ash only to find its way to growth, healing and resolve. The work is collectively inspired by forest fires in the Pacific Northwest and a longing to find solace and quiet from chaotic times, from the passing of loved ones and cherished friendships, from the esoteric search for meaning as we dare to step into the unknown beyond the duality of darkness and light. Among the Black Trees is Mercury's Antennae's most personal offering recorded as of yet.

While continuing to move their sonic artwork forward on these beautifully rendered compositions, the album captures the band in their progression towards darker, fuller sounds, unlike their previously loftier releases. The album explores Cindy's lower-tuned driving bass, Erick's fuzzy shimmery 12-string hollow-body guitar enveloped in echoing layered electronics, and Dru's dream-felt and delicate yet driven vocals that confront feelings of dissolution and the return to wholeness














FourColor

MATTHEW SHAW THE TOWER



"October in Cushendall is cold, November even more so and this was the time I spent inside The Tower. My days were spent either composing and recording or walking down to the coast, past a standing stone and back to a café and library for warmth. The music composed in The Tower was made using my daily experiences and impressions of Cushendall and the good people who call it home. I recorded squeaking doors, creaking steps, roaring fires, boy racers, and snatches of conversations from the pubs, café and streets. My internation was part audio collage and part composition. The elements were then sculpted together into their final form. I used Bill's unamplified gold flying V guitar, small hand-held synthesizers, an old 1970s Moog Prodigy, a loop and reverb pedal, plus the natural ambience of The Tower itself. Whilst fighting the cold in as many layers of clothing as possible."



This mesmerizing piece pays homage to Klein's travels with his wife to this coastal region and the awe-inspiring sites they witnessed and explored. The Oregon coast left an indelible mark, calling them back to its shores through this song.

MONSTER TAXI



Submotion Orchestra are a seven piece band formed in 2009 in Leeds, Yorkshire, England. They are influenced by dubstep, soul, ambient electronica, jazz and dub.

The original members of the band - Ruby Wood (vocals), Simon Beddoe (trumpet), Taz Modi (keyboards), Chris 'Fatty' Hargreaves (bass), Tommy Evans (drums), Danny
Templeman (percussion) and Dom 'Ruckspin' Howard (effects, production) - came together after an Arts Council-funded event to mix electronic and classical music at York
Minster in 2009. Their first EP was released in 2010 on Ranking Records, and led to a live session for BBC Radio One with Gilles Peterson. Their first album, Finest Hour,
was released in 2011 on Exceptional Records to positive reviews, with BBC Music saying 'this intriguing debut suggests the group as one to keep an eye on'.

Second album Fragments followed in 2012 to more critical acclaim, with Sputnikmusic saying 'the change in overall tone and some slight tweaks to their formula easily make this one of the year's must listen releases'. After releasing the 1968 EP on Circus Records in 2013, the band signed to Ninja Tune through their Counter Records imprint, and released Alium in 2014, the III EP in 2015 and Counter Theory in 2016.

After forming their own label, SMO Recordings, in 2018, the band released Kites, with The Skinny saying it 'marks a fine return to Submotion Orchestra's cinematic jazz roots'. Two Unplugged collections followed, with the band revisiting older tracks in an acoustic format, before touring with the Prism String Ensemble in 2023 to perform this material. In 2024, the band released the 'Five Points' EP and toured the UK to support it, including a headline appearance at the London Jazz Festival.
