ILUITEQ is an ambient music project founded by Sergio Calzoni and Andrea Bellucci, both respected musicians in the Italian experimental ambient scene. They have released several albums under various monikers and bands, including Red Sector A, Subterranean Source, Orghanon, and Colloquio.

In its apparent bare simplicity, "Fade, Remain" stands out as ILUITEQ's most uncompromising and intimate album to date. Addressing the universal human experience of loss and the transition into a new phase of life, ILUITEQ releases this new collaborative album co-written with renowned Italian producer and musician Eraldo Bernocchi. The album contrasts the idea of "fading," which signifies leaving or departing, with the concept of "remaining," whether physically or spiritually. The existential theme of the album gradually unfolds through the tracks, creating a sombre and sometimes mournful atmosphere.

With "Fade, Remain," ILUITEQ returns to the ambient-drone sound that characterized their earlier works, relying almost entirely on analog synths and outboard gear for production and mixing. Additional guitar and piano parts were incorporated later, while the field recordings found within the tracks were made in Bosco della Panfilia (Terre Del Reno, Italy). Rafael Anton Irisarri added an extra layer of depth to the tracks, utilising his extensive experience and craftsmanship as a mastering engineer to perfectly sculpt the bass frequencies and enhance the album's airy quality at his Black Knoll Studio.


