





In 1997, Thy Veils' first step on the musical scene by recording several songs on the tape called "Thy Veils, a short presentation of The Diaphanous Depressions".

The band signed a record deal with Powerplay Records in the following year and the audio cassette "Thy Veils

- Demo Tape One" is released. Following the positive reaction of the critics and the public, the material is
recorded in a professional studio and released as the first album, called "Prologue".

1999 saw the releases of their second album, called "Against an Oblivion of the Forgotten Abyss".. Due the increasing popularity, there are more invitations for interviews and public appearances.

"HMM 69", the most important Romanian music magazine, presents Thy Veils on the fourth place of the "Best new corners" category as well as on the fourth place on the "Best keyboard player" category, for the year 1998. Towards the end of the year a new album is released: "Thy Veils – Immemorable". at that time available as free download in mp3 format.

The 4th Thy Veils album, entitled "The Diaphanous Depressions", was recorded in 2000 and for the first time in Thy Veils' music there are spoken words, performed by Ciprian Costache and Daniel Dorobantu. The "Immemorable" CD reaches no.4 in the international chart at mp3.com, "Best Selling CD's" category. Thy Veils signed a contract with Stage and Frame Production Inc. from USA. As a result of this contract, 3 Thy Veils songs will be part of the "Good Neighbor" soundtrack, the next movie of this independent film company.

In 2001 Video Hammer Productions (USA) used Thy Veils' music as soundtrack in "The American Ghost Society's 2001 National Conference" video production. Nonnut Muzik released Thy Veils' 4th album, "The Diaphanous Depressions" CD.

Between 2003 & 2006 produced "Dawn And Furtherance", a 13 videos DVD, including 2 unreleased songs, complete with 5.1 surround sound mixing; the disk is not yet released, the videos are available online for stereo sound streaming.

With online downloading now in 2007 gaining momentum, their first 3 Thy Veils albums (Prologue, Against An Oblivion Of The Forgotten Abyss, Immemorable) are remastered and released as digital downloads.

The 5th Thy Veils album "Mountain and Cloud" is released in 2010. 






Thirty years later, Structures From Silence remains an iconic American release in the ambient and electronic genres. It's a well-respected soundtracks for contemplation, relaxation, meditation, and focused creativity. The album continues to appear at the top of charts and is mentioned as one of the best releases in the genre; even more importantly, it is a meaningful touchstone for thousands upon thousands of listeners who have lived many years within its nurturing embrace. The album has endured, growing more potent over time, especially in the accelerated pace of today's life. Emotional, powerful, and enriching, it is a living example of the true healing quality that music can hold. For Structures' 30th anniversary,

Steve went back to the original analog mixes for a 24/96k remaster that reveals luscious quality and subtle tonal detail not heard since the 1984 master. "With today's evolution of audiophile analog mastering tools," Steve says, "we were able to reveal the original beauty, detail and essence-of-tone captured on the 30 ips analog master which has not been heard like this until now."



The 3-CD deluxe edition includes two bonus discs created in 2013. Steve says, "Over the years since the creation of Structures From Silence, certain pieces would emerge in the studio that instantly had the resonance of a direct relationship to the place that birthed this work back in 1984. As this anniversary approached - like the light slowing emerging in an early morning sunrise returning from a thirty year orbit - the desire to draw from this place of stillness, and deep inner quiet became the soul tone for these new pieces. Like the three original tracks, these were created in moments spent simply being present in the studio, tapping the flow state and guiding this sense into these recorded moments." "Since its release, many listeners have praised the album's therapeutic and meditative qualitites, but Structures From Silence remains foremost a work of the heart, with tracks like 'Quiet Friend' forever evoking an aura of melancholic solitude. Whatever Brian Eno may have set in motion with his landmark Ambient series, Roach took a step further by creating something with a resounding sense of humanity and emotion." –Mark Burby, Alternative Press
















Kenta Kamiyama Signs Of Rain

Signs Of Rain is the debut album of the young musician Kenta Kamiyama, from Tokio, Japan. The album features a strong cohesion between the nine compositions contained, merging them into a stream of sounds which gently display to the listener a journey into everyday actions, with an intimate, yet slightly different, perspective.

The given picture is about an in-deep view of simple life settings that, under different light, acquire new meanings, making even the simplest action a fundamental life experience: a unique grants to the mutational shape that is human life, reflecting the observer mood that distinguishes Kenta.





Wolfgang Düren became more widely known to people as the chairman of Waldorf Music. Before founding Waldorf Music he partnered with Wolfgang Palm, the man behind PPG, and distributed his synths in the late seventies till the fall of PPG in the mid eighties. Later Wolfgang distributed the synths of Waldorf, Access and Novation with his company TSI. While he was distributing or later in charge of building synths, he was also a musician and rodie for Tangerine Dream. In the late seventies he recorded the LP "Eyeless Dream". This record featured many sounds of the early PPG wavetable synths that had just become available to some musicians searching for a new kind of sound beyond the conventional synth sounds using filters and modulations as main building blocks to shape their sound. These very new sounds in electronic music made this LP an insiders favourite over the years.
