TRANCEFUSION

Rudolf Heimann already played guitar and bass in various bands when he got to know keyboard instruments and integrated them into his home studio. Within a few years he became a synthesizer enthusiast and in 1991 he released his first regular album "Strange Delight".

So far, eight albums have been released, all of which reflect Heimann's preference for melodious, structured compositions. Unmistakable is the influence of the rock & pop genre, because Rudolf Heimann was initially inspired by progressive-melodic instrumental music (Alan Parsons, Mike Oldfield, Pink Floyd), before he got to know the classic German synthesizer music of the 70s.

Through his professional activities as a sound engineer and producer, he always remained in contact with handmade music and musicians, so that he could always enhance his instrumental productions with interesting and varied arrangements. Trancefusion is a remastered re-release of the 1993 album "Trancefusion"



ERISON SILVER BEACH To the electric guitar in some name that is prefront is Norwegian

When it comes to the electric guitar in Electronic Music, one name that is always at the forefront is Norwegian professional musician Erik Wollo. After over 30 years of innovative writing and recording, he has developed his own style, playing and composing not only very expressive synthesiser parts, but also blending it with his own guitar style.

This unique sounding combination has been the hallmark for around 25 solo studio albums and 5 EP/Mini albums that have been released worldwide. As well as these solo releases, Erik has worked with several other electronic musicians and co-written and released 18 collaboration albums, with Steve Roach, Ian Boddy, Byron Metcalf, Bernhard WÖstheinrich, amongst others. This makes a total of around 48 albums available from Erik, which is a collection not only for Erik to be proud of, but one that should take pride of place with any electronic music collector. Throughout this work, Erik has consistently created huge soundscapes, both from guitar and synthesisers, and layered them with sequences and melodies, when required, to create some of the most compelling ambient, as well as rhythmic pieces. Long may he continue!

KI(aus) are Jonathan Elliott and Stewart Lawler, plus a rotating roster of friends and collaborators. Originally from Tasmania, now living and working in Sydney, the pair have known each other for several decades and formed KI(aus) in 2013 over a beer and a shared appreciation of Tangerine Dream's 79-85 period. They both have long experience in the

music industry - Lawler, formerly a member of Sydney techno-pop outfit Boxcar has spent much of the last ten years touring with Tom Ellard's Severed Heads. Elliott is a classically trained pianist who played in multiple local bands in the 1990s, touching on numerous genres and styles.

"I'm getting a bit hesitant to call us straight-up Berlin School these days," says Lawler, "I think we've moved beyond that with this album in some ways. Maybe it's my classical background but when I'm mixing our tracks I tend to think of each instrument contributing their own line as part of an ensemble, which is not a million miles from the way our favourite Froese/Franke/Schmoelling era Tangerine Dream tracks used to work either. Plus the album format is probably as close as I'll ever get to working on long-form 'classical' music. One of our aims, after all, has been to reclaim electronic music from the dance floor and put it back into the concert hall.'

From the melancholy, dream-like state of "Alma Febles Struggles Into The Night" to the joyous exuberance of "Mammatus Clouds Over Saskatchewan"; via the pompous grandiosity of "On The News It Looked Like She Was Floating" and the whimsical proto-synthwave of "Heroes of 1986", KI(aüs) 2 is an album of fantastic, inventive synth classicism. Losing none of the Australian charm or fondness for intriguing track titles as displayed on the 2016 debut album (also released on Castles in Space), this LP promises to be an instant and enduring classic.



ROBERT SCHROEDER TIME WAVES







German electronic composer Robert Schroeder is a highly regarded creator of ambient, often experimental soundscapes. Born in Aachen, Germany, on May 20, 1955, Schroeder first became interested in music around age 13 after receiving his first guitar. He soon began exploring experimental sounds and techniques, eventually giving up playing in 1970 to completely immerse himself in electronics and engineering.

After high school Schroeder worked in researching and developing electronic instruments, in his off hours honing his own synthesizer sound; in 1978 he signed to Klaus Schulze's Innovative Communication label, and a year later released his debut album, Harmonic Ascendant. The aptly titled Floating Music followed in 1980, and with 1981's Mosaique, Schroeder began combining electronics with live instrumentation; the follow-up, Galaxie Cygnus A, was created in conjunction with a multimedia presentation.

In 1982 Pegasus was released without Schroeder's consent; his next official release was 1983's Paradise. After returning a year later with Computer Voice, in 1985 he issued his soundtrack to the 3D film Brain Voyager. After releasing 1986's Universal Ave. as one half of the duo Double Fantasy with Charly McLion, Schroeder returned to his solo career to issue Time Waves, his most acclaimed effort to date. With 1991's Hamaja, he formed his own label, NEWSmusic; subsequent releases included 1993's Mindwalk and 1994's Everdreams.

After going on hiatus until the mid-2000s, Schroeder resumed his musical explorations and released a number of albums on the Spheric label, including 2006's Brainchips, 2007's Sphereware, and 2010's Cream. More atmospheric, lounge-ready efforts followed for the label, including 2011's Club Chil, Vol. 1, 2012's Ferro Oxid, and 2014's '80s-influenced Backspace. In 2017, the ever-prolific Schroeder delivered the ambient-sounding Velocity. Recent releases include Spaceland 2018 & Fata Morgana 2019.





computerchemist

Computerchemist is the ongoing solo project of Dave Pearson.
ARFM DJ Bruce Gall has remarked on the crossover style of his playing, invoking comparisons to electronic artists Tangerine Dream, Jean-Michel Jarre, Klaus Schulze, Kraftwerk, and the progressive sounds of Pink Floyd and David Gilmour solo work, Ash Ra Tempel, Mike Oldfield, Steve Hackett, Brian Eno and King Crimson.

From the energy and light of the title track "icon one" to the darkness and entropy of "icon zero"; the past memories recalled by "timethorns" and the focal centre of the album "chaos theory" - where a small, insignificant event can cause a massive shift of everything - computerchemist weaves an evocative blend of instrumental synthesis which is sure to delight fans of the EM genre. The last track, "the message", carries a simple premise; we all have within us the power to change the future.

After being invited to play the Snow Bawl concert in February 2019, I decided to release the concert track (Machine Code) along with some sketches made in the week leading up to the concert.

The concert was a gathering of musicians using Modular Synthesisers. I took my "Strawberry Box", a reclaimed wooden container used to sell punnets of Strawberry's, re-purposed as a Eurorack system. I also used some semi-modular gear with Lexicon and Eventide outboard effects. The resulting system was very playable. While the tracks presented here share a definite root, you can hear just how much the live atmosphere drove the concert version in a very different direction.

Adrian got into electronic music in the 70's when he built his first synthesiser at school. He quickly discovered Tangerine Dream and Klaus Schulze and fell in love with improvised electronic music. At University he met John and Pete, later to become AirSculpture.

Single DISTANT VISIONS

Most times, I'll work on an idea, and pick it up week after week, month after month, and sometimes years apart before something truly clicks.

Distant Visions was not one of those tracks.

Things seemed to just fall into place early on, and most of the day was just spent tweaking; fine tuning; and getting the mix just where I wanted it. I couldn't be happier with the result.

This song marks the beginning of many things. The first song I've released in 2019, as well as the first song on what may in fact become, a sequel to The Maestoso Interstellar Suite.

Project Infinity

Will be released in volumes, and it will never have an end. Only slight intermissions.

When I feel like entering back into that world and putting more work into Infinity, I'll just release another volume until Infinity (Or I die, or I give up... whichever comes first).

You might think I'm crazy, but hey I'm doing this for myself. I hope you guys like it, but it's my baby So with that said, I'll start by working on Infinity Volume 1.

I've already determined how the movements from "The Maestoso Interstellar Suite" will be spread across the various different volumes, for the first three volumes of Infinity (in which Volume 3 will contain completely new material).

I'll be trimming just a bit from one movement for the first volume and start working on the new arrangements. Once that is complete expect to hear more news on how I'm proposing to have the final release done. On top of that I also have work on binarywaste and VR I need to complete as well, so I'm unsure of a time frame at this time... but I'm excited to get back to the now never ending suite. Stay tuned, as the first 4 volumes for Infinity are underway.

Mihail Doma eptune

Mihail Doman

Mihail Doman's second album delves deeper into contemporary orchestral music, with a minimalist string score. Its themes blend in and out of the electronic soundscapes, making for a reflective listening experience. Traditionally the ruler of water and the seas, Neptune is the 2nd farthest planet from the Sun, featuring a deep azure blue hue which makes its given name befitting indeed. It's an alien place with hundred-mile-per-hour winds and diamonds raining from the sky.

Neptune the Mystic. There's an analogy to be made here between Neptune the planet, and Neptune as a symbol for our collective unconscious. That's where the dreams and ideals of humanity are born. And that's where they are molded and prepared to become diamonds in their own right.

Coming back to the sound, the album features themes written for seven voices, but in a modern, minimalistic manner. Therefore, there's a focus on the emotional gravitas of the harmony and the chords before anything else. Influenced a lot by the sound of today's film soundtracks, Mihail uses a number of electronic instruments and synthesizers, complementing the organic textures of the orchestra. Synth pads and effects create a whole new sound world, one in which the listener can enter, and one which he can explore.



inSPYRAtion

"live in SOLINGEN"

"inSPYRAtion is the live recording of their concert, which DER Spyra & Roksana Vikaluk gave during the Solingen "sequenzen" festival. A great set played live on mainly analogue equipment in SUEDPARK GALERIE during that day."

Wolfgang Spyra says about the concert: "we have to return to improvisation with unpredictable, analog sound structures! Not in the sense of "everything was better in the old days", but nevertheless in the sense of complex structures of sequential sounds, which challenge us, the live musicians today, not to reel off a ready-made program, but to play, discover, and us to be surprised by things that, beyond presets and storable processes, allow a direct flow that cannot be pre-planned







may believe. In fact, the band name was formed by taking the two first letters of the founder members PEter Kommers and RUud van Es in 1979.

In 1981, they released their debut album 'Macchu Picchu' on which Rob Papen appeared as a guest musician. The first album was recorded live on a 2-track recorder. Macchu Picchu caught the attention of Dutch radio stations and a then a bit later on, Peter, Ruud, and Rob went on to form a 2nd group called Nova which then led to the number 1 hit 'Aurora' in the Netherlands and Belgium charts of April 1982. In the same year, they also produced the PERU 'Constellations' album which was recorded semi-live on 4-track in their own HNS Studio, situated in a little basement studio found in the heart of Dordrecht. By the year 1983, the album 'Continents' was written and recorded on an 8-track tape recorder in HNS studio.

The album 'Points of the Compass' followed in 1986 and was also recorded, and mixed in the HNS studio, but this time on a 24-track. Then the albums 'Forlian' in 1988 and 'Moon 1991' were recorded and included a new guest musician and composer 'Jos van den Dungen'.

In 1988 PERU remixed their song 'Africa' from the 1983 album 'Continents' and released a 12-inch remix version of it. The remix of Africa went on to become a number 1 hit in Austria in the same year. 'The Prophecies' in 1993 was the last PERU album which was very different from all the other albums. But the story of PERU doesn't end there....

Now 25 years later PERU's new album 'The Return' is released!.

In 2015 the recording sessions started in earnest with Ruud and Rob at the helm and in contrast with the first PERU album which was played live using hardware on a 2-track tape recorder, this album has been fully produced using music software.

Our blast from the past includes and early Peru track 'Vally' on the 1989 Klem Compilation CD





The Catherings recorded in concert at St Mary's Church, Philadelphia, USA on 20th October 2018


The music on The Gatherings disc features some tracks from his previous studio album As Above So Below (DiN51) as well as new material composed specifically for this concert. Boddy performed the show playing analogue keyboards and a modular set up borrowed over in the USA alongside Ableton Live laptop work. Muscular analogue sequenced grooves are overlaid with atmospheric beds of FX as well as grandiose sweeping chords. The music gradually building up to the climax of the track The Thaumaturge from his As Above So Below album for which the audience certainly show their appreciation.

The second disc from the Star's End show is a more introspective set with atmospheric string interludes over deep ambient soundscapes. The music gradually crystallises into a delicate sequencer on Spire before the full Berlin School sequencer work out of Apostasy. Full of haunting tones the final track Remnants closes the set which works as a perfect companion disc to the earlier Gatherings concert.

Altair thus shows Boddy at the height of his powers playing two very different concerts within a few hours of each other in very different venues. Produced in a beautiful fold out 6 panel digipak this double CD album is a must for both Boddy fans as well as lovers of live electronic music.




The album will be released on 17th of May by the renowned Chillout/Ambient label Sine Music and will be available as a limited CD as well as on all known download and streaming portals.






ZEN is the 8th solo album of Axess and the sequel to Seashore. It consequently follows the musical route which has started a few years ago. The new CD starts with peaceful pads and warm harmonies which make you relaxed instantly. But don't trust the peace for too long, already in the 2nd track you will be woken up and suddenly find yourself in a different world of deep basses and hypnotic beats. On the audio CD all 8 tracks of ZEN are combined with each other to form one single piece of musical art. Ideally it should be listened without any interruptions and with headphones it would be even more perfect to let you enter the new musical cosmos of Axess.





Digital Horizons Formed in 1988 after a discovery of Tangerine Dream and a purchase of a £130 mono Casio keyboard. Based in Norfolk, UK. Justin Ludford is the founding member and to this date sole member of Digital Horizons. Born in 1973, with a continued interest in electronic music, a bedroom studio culture progressed to the present day.

Nostalgia, but without the dust. Eight tracks inspired by old unreleased cassette projects pre 2001. Recorded Feb/April 2019.
